<u>Bible Supplies</u>: Remember our goal is to create a treasure for them to have and use to study. It is important to have this ready to go and tabbed before the first day of school.

- KJV Kids Study Bible Hendrickson Publishers, ISBN #1598563513. Christianbook Distributors usually has the best price. You may get the hard back or a leather of your choice (but must be Hendrickson Publishers). We do not have a formal Bible curriculum in 4th grade, therefore, this particular Bible is our textbook. We will be doing a visual survey of the Old Testament Bible which I will explain more about at our first meeting.
- Bible Tabs Books of the Bible make sure your Bible is fully tabbed before the first day
- **Plastic shoe box with lid** labeled with student name inside this box, please have the following items ready to go:
 - Black pen that is .5 fine point (important to note make sure the pen does not bleed through paper)
 - \circ $\;$ The above Bible that is tabbed and ready to go for the first day of school.
 - Small pack of colored pencils (we use these to highlight)
