

4th Grade Supply List for 2025-26

Bible Supplies: Remember our goal is to create a treasure for them to have and use to study. It is important to have this ready to go and tabbed before the first day of school. These will be used in 4th and 5th grade

- KJV Kids study bible -Hendrickson publishers, ISBN# 1598563513 (tabbed with books of the Bible tabs) *Christian Book distributors* usually has the best price- you can get the hard back or leather your choice) We do not have a formal Bible curriculum in 4th grade therefore this particular BIBLE is our textbook - We will be doing a visual survey of the Old Testament Bible which I will explain more about at our first meeting.
- Plastic shoe box with lid labeled with student name – inside this box please have the following items ready to go: **I will give them timelines and extra stuff that will be kept in these boxes.**
- **Bible that has been tabbed- We will use these starting the first day of class-**Sometimes we will do Bible outside -this way all they need will be in box ready to go

General Supplies

Plastic pocket folders: for durability

- **Red** for home day papers
- **Yellow** for English / Reading
- **Blue** for agenda and communication log
- **Green** for science
- **1" binder with dividers labeled for Bible and Novel Study.**
- Headphones labeled with name – for computer use -no earbuds please – put in a gallon Ziploc bag with name on bag too. (Their student cards will be kept with the bag and earphones)
- Clipboard – labeled with name
- ruler -clearly marked with inches and centimeters (a 6-inch ruler is best and will fit in pencil box and make marking their Bible easier)
- Pack of wide ruled loose leaf paper for class to share

2 Pencil boxes — label with name- pack before school starts please- they will keep one at their desk and the other one with art supplies in cubbie until needed- (only put what they need in their box -extra supplies like extra pencils, erasers etc... need to stay at home until needed- I have limited storage space)

In Art box please pack – These will stay in their cubbies

(Label everything and please put a piece of tape on the bottom of each box to prevent spillage – Thank you)

- Colored pencils
- Fine tip markers
- 24 count crayons
- Black sharpie

- Scissors- pointed scissors (your child is getting older please get them scissors that are large enough for their hands and comfortable – we do a lot of cutting and every year I have students whose scissors are too small for them)
- 2 glue sticks

In Desk pencil box please pack -these stay at their tables at all times

- pencils#2 (mechanical ones are fine too)
 - pencil top erasers
 - large eraser
 - hand held pencil sharpener (optional)
 - 2 fine dry erase markers different colors
 - old sock/eraser for math
 - Ruler with centimeters and inches that is clear to read -be careful pretty rulers sometimes don't have both and are hard to read-
- PLEASE- Go ahead and pack their pencil box so they will be ready for the first day of school – Having these two boxes may seem excessive however, trust me it will keep their items secure, neat, and easy to grab for in class projects.

North Carolina Notebook

- White 2 inch binder with clear sleeve on front- I will show you one of these at our first meeting completed – we will begin this project in class the second week of school (more info at Parent Collaboration meeting). If you go somewhere in NC this summer take pictures – they will also need pictures of their county courthouse, famous landmarks etc.... most can be printed later from the internet. Just giving you a heads up as this is a graded assignment and an NC History completion.
- 50 Clear protective sheets

Optional Supplies needed for Classroom:

If you would like to send these in January instead of now let me know. Families with multiple children, I understand this can be an expense and our storage is limited, as well.

- Paper towels
- Natural sanitizing wipes (Seventh Generation, etc)
- Tissues
- White cardstock paper (we use a lot of card stock for many things, learning games, cards to encourage timelines etc...)
