1. Pick a Topic

Pick a word and find any similar words.
i.e., repent/ repentance

2. Questions

Write down all questions you want answered through this Bible study.

3. Word Study

- a. Concordance
- b. Blue Letter Bible
- c. Definition

a. Concordance

Find ALL Strong's numbers that translate from the original language to that word.

b. Blue Letter Bible

Look up the Strong's numbers and find the Part of Speech, Root Word (Etymology), and Translations.

c. Definition

Using a dictionary (Merriam-Webster), define the word according to the correct part of speech.

4. Scriptures

- a. Using the Blue Letter Bible app look up the topic, to find all scripture containing the topic word.
- b. Using a search engine, search “scripture on (topic), to find other scriptures that talk about the topic but do not contain the topic word.

5. Interpretation

- **to explain or tell the meaning of**

Take all the information you have learned and explain what the bible says about the topic.

6. Application

- **To put to use especially for some practical purpose; to bring into action; to lay or spread on; to put into operation or effect.**

Things to do:

- Claim any promises
- Plan to obey instruction or commands
- Correct any beliefs
- Pray (repentance)
