

# Word Study

## Guide

### Steps

1. Choose a word
2. Define the word
3. Find other scriptures
4. Read other translations
5. Note Bible Usage
6. Write the strong's definition
7. Gather info from other sources
8. Write your takeaways
9. Write Rewrite the verse
10. Pray & Meditate

### 1. Choose a Word

There are many ways to go about selecting a word.  
(Repeated words, words that stand out, confusing words, etc...)

### 2. Define the Word

Define the word using a standard dictionary  
(Merriam-Webster's)

### 3. Find Other Scriptures

Find other scriptures that use the same word. Use  
BlueLetterBible.com to search the word and write down  
2-4 other verses the word is in.

### 4. Read Other Translations

Read other translations to note whether or not a synonym is  
used for the word you are studying.

## 5. Note Bible Usage

- a. Using the Blue Letter Bible app look up the word, and click on the Interlinear tab.
- b. Scroll down until you see the word you are studying.
- c. Click the strong's number for your word and scroll down until you see "Outline of Bible Usage" and take note of any words that resonates with you.

## 6. Write the Strong's Definition

Write down the strong's definition of your word.

## 7. Gather Information From Other Sources

Gather information from other sources such as concordances, bible dictionaries, etc...

## 8. Write Down Your Takeaways

Write down your thoughts using the information you have gathered.

## 9. Rewrite the Verse

First write the original verse you found the word in. Then rewrite the verse using your newfound definition.

## 10. Pray

Pray and meditate over what you have learned.
