A YEAR OF COMMUNITY IMPACT

Over the last 18 months we have delivered practical education, community engagement and wellbeing programmes reaching children, families, older adults and residents through schools, venues, libraries and holiday programmes.

SCHOOL MONEY WORKSHOP

In March 2026, **140** children participated in an interactive financial literacy workshop covering saving, budgeting, needs versus wants, smart spending, scam awareness, and decision-making. The workshop strengthened participants' confidence in discussing money, understanding of saving, financial decision-making, and teamwork and communication skills.



"HAF" PROGRAMME

During the school holidays we delivered our Money Game, Moves & Meals programme, combining financial education, physical activity, healthy eating, confidence building and teamwork.

*The programme recorded **105** attendances from children aged 5-17, helping them stay active, learn essential life skills and enjoy nutritious meals in a safe, inclusive environment.*



COMMON GROUND PROJECT

110 residents from different backgrounds came together through listening circles, shared storytelling, money confidence activities. Culture Connect conversations and community challenges and a toolkit creation were the outcomes for the national Common Ground initiative by the Ministry of Housing, Communities & Local Government (MHCLG) Stronger communities were built as people felt heard, respected and connected.

DIGITAL INCLUSION

*Older adults and residents lacking digital confidence received practical support to access online services, stay connected, avoid scams, communicate with family and improve confidence using technology. Many participants progressed from never using digital devices independently to completing everyday online tasks with confidence. We reached over **60** people.*



LEARNING BEYOND THE CLASSROOM

*Our online learning programmes continued expanding our reach beyond face-to-face delivery, with **3000** learners enrolled and **2000+** educational resources downloaded. Flexible learning was made available for children, parents and adults alike.*





SYSTEMS CHANGE

Our programmes contribute to long-term systems change by promoting financial wellbeing, reducing digital barriers, strengthening community cohesion, supporting early intervention through practical skills, and preventing problems from escalating—helping to reduce pressure on public services and improve outcomes for individuals and communities.

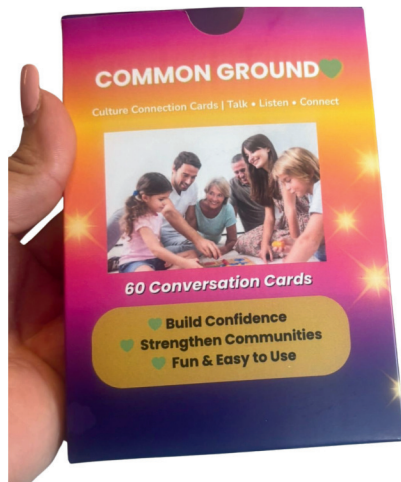
