


In the middle of July, the Leadership Board asked the congregation of Galilee to raise \$125,888 by September 1st to replace the church's roof and to support the ELCA's Equipping the Saints drive. As of August 30th, **YOU DID IT!** We have raised \$126,886, just over the \$125,888 goal! That's AWESOME! Galilee has always come through in a time of need and we should be proud that putting our Faith in God has allowed us to continue that tradition. Any extra funds raised that are not needed for the roof project will be used to pay down our mortgage.

The work on the roof should start in late September or early October so the next time you fly over Galilee, the roof will look a little different!

As many of you may know, since 2006, Galilee has been in partnership with a small church located in a rural community outside of San Salvador, the capital city of El Salvador. The church is called El Renacer de Los Martires, which means "The Return of the Martyrs" or "The Rebirth of the Martyrs." It's located in a small village called La Comunidad de Mosenor Romero. Monsenor Romero was a well-known and beloved church leader in El Salvador. He became the Archbishop of El Salvador in 1977. His ministry focused on serving the poor. He also spoke out against social injustice, including the political torture and assassinations occurring in El Salvador at that time.

For many years, the Pastor at El Renacer de Los Martires has been Pastor Martir. Working with Pastor Martir and through monetary donations, Galilee members have provided important improvements to the church property, including electricity, a new roof, a Sunday School building for the children, and a fence around the church property. We have also provided resources for worship and education, including teaching materials, technology resources, hymnals, and bibles to assist Pastor Martir in his ministry. Most recently, through some generous donations, we provided new ceramic tiling for the church and Sunday School buildings.

There have been many Galilee delegation visits to El Salvador over the years. During those visits, Galilee members worship, share fellowship and conversation, listen to the needs of the community, share meals, and provide support in the Principle of Accompaniment. In short, we come together and build relationships. We are planning another delegation trip to El Salvador for mid-2025. Details on that to follow.

Each year, we're pleased to assist with funds for backpacks, school supplies, and socks for the children in the community, many of whom walk quite a distance through fields and over dirt roads to get to the local school. We also provide funds for annual church celebrations, including a Christmas party, a Mothers' Day celebration, and annual celebrations honoring the birthday of our partner church and the life of Archbishop Romero.

If you already knew all this, great! If this information is new to you, that's great too! We welcome providing you with opportunities to learn more.

During September, you will be hearing more about the El Salvador partnership and how you could become involved.
