# **PASTOR AMANDA APPLEHANS**



Tortillas, ciabatta, rice cakes, baguette, pita, or challah – no matter how you slice it, we all know bread when we see it. Wikipedia's "History of Bread" page starts by saying, "Bread was central to the formation of early human societies." We have found remnants of bread at archaeological sites that was baked around 14,000 years ago. Though it has fallen out of favor somewhat in recent years, bread has been a foundational part of the human diet for thousands of years.

During the month of August we will dwell in the sixth chapter of John, the "Bread of Life Discourse." We will hear of how Jesus fed 5,000 men with just 5 loaves and 2 fish. We will hear him compare himself to the manna the Israelites ate in the wilderness, even going so far as to say, "I am the Bread of Life." We will hear Jesus tell his followers (then and now) that we must eat of his body and drink his blood. We will hear the response to this declaration from the leaders of the people, the people themselves, and even Jesus's own disciples. We will watch as this hard teaching causes many to turn back from following Jesus. Then we will hear Jesus ask if even his 12 apostles would turn away, and we will hear Peter say, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life." Alleluia!

As we walk through this month of bread and sustenance, I invite you all to consider the following questions. When you pray, in what ways do you ask God to care for you? Where do you go when you are seeking God's presence? What do you think it means to eat Jesus's flesh and drink his blood in Holy Communion? Considering God tends to show up where we don't expect God to be, where should we go to seek God's presence?

These are indeed hard teachings, but they are also important teachings. It is fitting that we would take a few weeks and dwell in the concept of Jesus as our daily bread – that which sustains us, nurtures us, is knit into our very bodies and becomes a part of who we are. Let us rest in this image of Jesus as the food which preserves us, and in the promise that "the one who eats this bread will live forever."







# **AUGUST UPDATE FROM THE LEADERSHIP BOARD**

#### WE ARE RAISING THE ROOF!

We are scheduled to have the roof replaced at Galilee and we are actively raising funds to pay for this project. Within the past week you should have received a note in the mail, possibly have read a note on-line or heard a Leadership Board member talk about the roof replacement project (and if you haven't seen the letter please click <a href="here">here</a> for further details).

The current roof has had a series of leaks and it was determined a few years ago that this was a project we needed to undertake before major damage occurred. Last year we had a team put together who reviewed our needs, interviewed firms that bid on the project and made a final vendor selection. The ideal time to install a roof was mentioned repeatedly to be in late summer/early fall as the temps start to drop a bit but the weather is still fairly dry (although we'll see if that holds for this year!). With this knowledge we chose to have the project completed in late September and at this time are on schedule for this to occur.

We will need to provide an additional payment to the company completing the work in September and then final payment shortly after they finish. In total, we are looking to raise roughly \$126,000.00. Our target date for raising these funds is by September 1st. This gives us the month of August to ask, cajole, beg or do what is needed to complete this task.

Please note that if the money is not raised our back-up plan is to take out a loan to pull the final payments together. We are strongly hoping that this is not a route we have to take. Galilee's mortgage is scheduled to be paid off in approximately one year. We would ideally like to retire this debt and not have more debt extended. Galilee has been paying on a debt that was created 25 years ago. While that expense was needed and all of us are enjoying our beautiful spaces it's time to chart a new course with new ideas free from past decisions. Our ask is that you will please consider donating to this project –

this is our house and this work needs to be completed.

#### SPECIAL THANKS TO ALL OF OUR VOLUNTEERS

This year, and particularly this summer, we have had a number or requests for volunteers for a number of activities at Galilee. With significant assistance from the congregation various roles have been filled –from the folks who volunteer as worship assistants, to those who are tying blankets to those who have helped with general housekeeping chores in and around the Church and grounds to those who have stepped up to help with the Farmers Market, as well as many other projects and tasks, we want to say <a href="thank you">thank you</a> to you all. There are lots of things to do at Galilee – some are fun and some are just plain work but all are important. This congregation runs with your help and we are grateful that Galilee's members continues to step up and make the church a priority in your lives. As with many things, saying thank you doesn't feel to be enough to share appreciation for your efforts but please know everyone's efforts are recognized and are definitely appreciated. We hope that you all will discover places here where you will share your gifts and get involved.

As summer starts to wind down later this month please keep Rally Sunday on your schedule in September. School will come and the season will change but Galilee will be here, where we will walk with Jesus, sharing God's love and grace and serving ALL faithfully!
