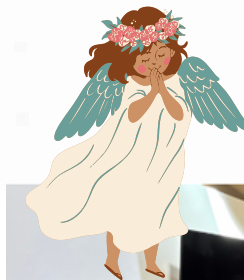

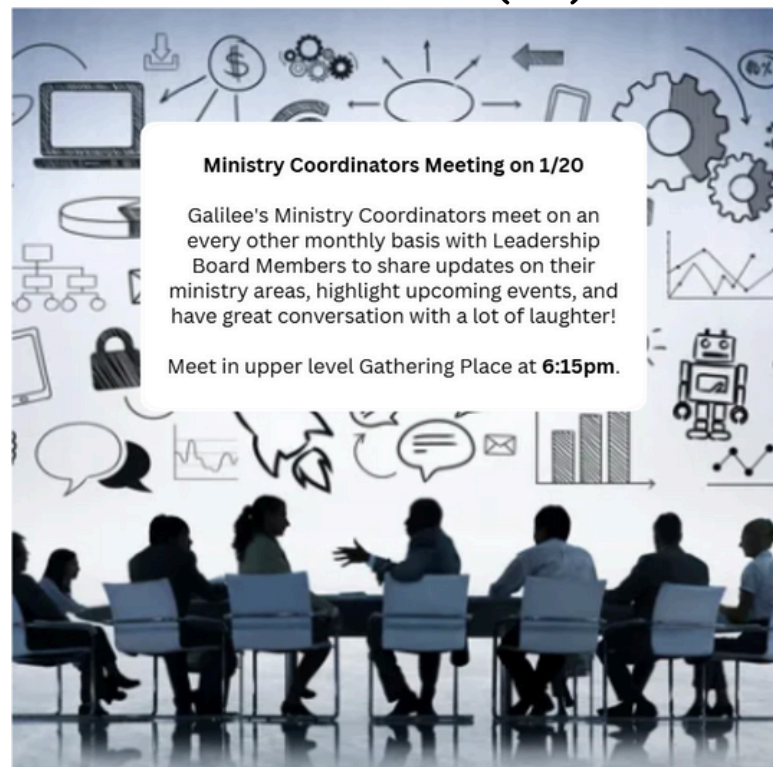

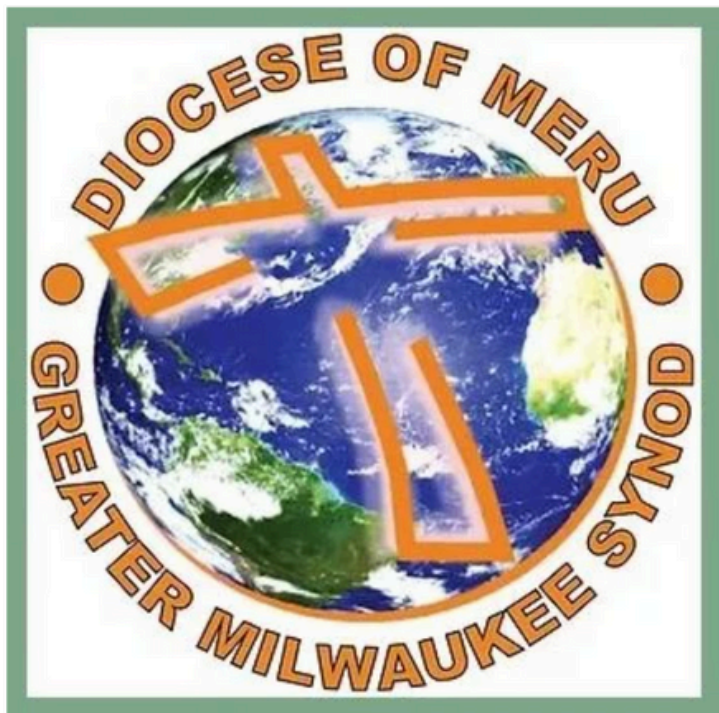


Speaking of Pop...
