ADVENTURE CLASS 101 REQUIREMENTS

Adventure Class runs the full year, both fall and spring sessions. By signing up for class, you will be expected to attend for the duration.

Teacher approval is required. Please be advised that there is an ongoing waitlist and a class maximum of 6 students.

Must be over 16 by the first class in September.

A valid passport is required. If you do not have one, you will need to apply for one prior to the start of class in September (and provide proof that it's in the works). The cost is \$165 for the passport application, \$10 - \$20 for the passport photos, and you will need access to your personal documentation (Soc. Sec. #, ID). The instructor can assist in the application process if needed.

There will be between one and four instructor-led fundraisers outside of school hours. Students are heavily encouraged to participate and will receive a pro-rated percentage based on their involvement. Each student will be responsible for their individual costs beyond what is raised. Instructor will be mindful of the cost and attempt to keep it low. However, the final financial decisions will rest primarily with the students.

Once the student has committed to the trip financially (they are able to confirm or back out once final cost information becomes available) they will be expected to follow through. Withdrawal after commitment puts the burden of their cost on the rest of the team, as we will have made bookings and purchases based on a specific group number.

A laptop or device and access to the internet will be needed for the class Discord server, research, and homework completion. A notebook will suffice during class hours.

This class has weekly homework assignments. Completion of assignments is required to participate in any trip.

To be considered for this class, the following interviews must take place:

Interview 1: Via phone/in person (Aug/Sept), regarding class requirement and contract. A parent MUST be present if the student is a minor.

Interview 2: In person (at the end of orientation day), regarding student's suitability for the class

Finally, parents and family members who would like to join the trip will have to make all travel plans independently (transportation, lodging, flights, meals...etc).
