## Arrival & Cleanup

We expect all students to arrive 15 minutes prior to their first class and be prepared to begin on time. At 5 before the end of each hour, instructors dismiss the students and they are given 5 minutes to get to their next class and be ready to work when it begins.

Students should not leave their classroom at the end of the day until the room is completely clean. This includes sweeping/vacuuming the floors, stacking chairs, cleaning whiteboards, cleaning tables, emptying the trash and replacing the liners…etc. Once that is complete, students will join in the all-school clean-up.

## Lost & Found

## **Class Changes**

Students may only change classes within the first two weeks of a semester. They must obtain a Change of Class Form and have it approved and signed by both instructors (releasing and accepting) and a Director.

### Art Exhibit & Revue

The Art Revue is a celebration and finale that marks the end of a term and the culmination of all of our students' hard work. You are welcome and encouraged to invite your family and friends to come and enjoy the event!

All artwork must be properly labeled and turned in by the end of Crazy Day (the last school day of the term). One piece of art per student, per class may be submitted. All artwork must be matted or framed (not behind glass), and labeled as follows:

AFAN reserves the right to post image of the artwork submitted for any/all purposes, as well as group photos.

## Supplies

General supplies (paper, pencils, erasers, printing, first canvas...etc.) are provided by the school.

Specialized supplies are required for certain classes and must be purchased by the student. A supply list can be found on our website under the class description. You can also ask an instructor or the office for direction on where/what to purchase.

Students without required supplies will be unable to partake in class lessons, so please make sure to have what you need by the beginning of the session!





## Respect

AFAN desires to create a loving and encouraging atmosphere for all students. We do not tolerate the use of demeaning language or physical aggression/abuse, which will be immediately reported to the office. Students who bully or put down another student will be sent to the office after the first warning. If the negative behavior continues, AFAN will meet with the student and parent for a probationary meeting. One further infraction and the student will be asked to leave.

Instructors, students, and/or parents who gossip, slander, or physically abuse anyone at AFAN will be asked to leave the school.

## **No Darkness**

Art is inherently subjective, with as many different styles as there are people on earth. However, here at AFAN we hold to very clear moral standards according to our faith. Any artwork, literature, clothing, language, or behavior that glorifies darkness and evil will not be permitted.

## Support

Art For All Nations needs the support of our students, their families, and the community! If possible, find a way to work with teachers, volunteer in a needed position, and/or find a way to support your children during their time at school.

AFAN is more than a school; it is a ministry. Our staff puts in a great deal of time and effort to make it successful for your children, volunteering many additional hours of their time outside of, and during, school hours.

We strongly encourage everyone to support our school, instructors, and students in order to ensure a fun and successful session.

Negative attitudes are not permitted. If there is a legitimate complaint, please lodge it with the school administration so a reasonable solution may be found.

We desire success and growth for all of our students, and know that your support makes their success possible.

## Guests

All guests (ANY non-student or staff) must sign in at the office and receive a visitor's pass. Guests are only allowed in classes with a day pass (\$30 fee). All other guests must stay in reception until classes have been dismissed. Students and parents who are interested in the school may come for an hour visit without paying a fee.

## Electronics & Phones

No phone calls, texting, gaming, or general device use is permitted in class. If you need to contact your parents, let your instructor know and you will be allowed to go to the office to make the call.

Policy on music is set by the instructor of each class, so check in with them for information.

If you bring your own music to school, you are permitted to listen privately on your own time. However, you may not share your device with other students.

If music and phone rules are not followed, your devices will be taken to the office for the day and you may pick them up after your last class.

### **Dress Code**

Students are asked to dress modestly and conscientiously (no dark messaging on your attire).

## Tuition Costs & Fees

**Registration Fee (Per Session):** A \$45 non-refundable Registration Fee is due at the beginning of each session (or \$75.00 for both sessions). All students enrolling in Art For All Nations must pay the registration and supply fees.

**Supply Fee (Per Session):** A supply fee is due at the beginning of every session for all students. This fee helps to cover the cost of the supplies provided by the school.

Full-Time (3-5 classes) student: \$35 Part-Time (2 classes) student: \$25 Single Class student: \$15

**Tuition:** Tuition and all fees are due by the first day of school (orientation day).

If this is a challenge, an installment plan can be established for the session. Fall session can be broken into five payments, and spring session into four payments.

These payments are due by the 2nd Wednesday of each month.

Per Session:

Full-Time (3-5 classes) student: \$825.00. Part-Time (2 classes) student: \$575.00. Single class: \$350.00.

Family Discount: We offer a discount of 20% for each additional full-time student (family only). We also offer 5% discount for payment in full. We accept cash, check, and card.

**Scholarships:** AFAN offers a limited number of scholarships each year. Applications can be requested at the office or via e-mail. The school board will evaluate each scholarship application and applicants will be notified of their decision.

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS: All scholarship recipients are required to participate in AFAN fundraisers (such as the Go 4th Festival, Calendar sales...etc). Our fundraisers are what provide us the opportunity to give out scholarships.
