Scholarship and it's benefits?

- ❖ A scholarship is a form of financial aid, provided to a student by a university to further their education.
- ❖ Winning a scholarship nets you more than just a healthy bank balance. Many colleges offer support to students that have won scholarships, to help them get the most out of their money.

The Fulbright Masters and Ph.D. The program funds graduate study in the United States. Funded by the United States Department of State, these grants cover tuition, required textbooks, airfare, a living stipend, and health insurance. USEFP also assists with the visa process.

Eligibility Criteria

- Pakistani citizens with strong academic histories, residing (throughout the process) in Pakistan and committed to returning and serving Pakistan are welcome to apply.
- People in the fields of energy, water, agriculture, health, education, social sciences, and the environment are strongly encouraged to apply.
- Eligible Master's applicants will have a four-year Bachelor's degree or a Bachelor's and Master's combination (16 years of formal education) Applicants should be prepared to complete grants without accompanying dependents if need be.

Cycle

Applications are accepted each year in February and the deadline to submit an application is around May. The application review and interview process continue until September and the results are announced in mid-October.

❖ Erasmus Mundus Scholarship

- In this scholarship, you will study in Europe in 03 European countries at 03 universities and get a dual degree awarded by two European universities.
- You will get a fully funded scholarship with an almost 1100-1200 Euros per month stipend (250,000 plus above PKR per month). Travelling is paid separately from the stipend.
- No tuition fee.
- Chances to study, make friends of different languages and cultures, and travel all around Europe free of cost.
- So you can easily search for and get a job in Europe. This degree is highly admired by companies in Europe & USA.

Erasmus Mundus is not a single programme; it comprises hundreds of EMJM programmes. Each programme is offered and managed by a different consortium of universities, and each programme has its own set of requirements and selection criteria.

❖ DAAD Scholarship Germany

- The DAAD Scholarship in Germany is the world's largest funding organization for international students from developing countries.
- The DAAD scholarships are awarded to students who want to complete a full-time course of study with mandatory attendance in Germany.
- The applicant should have completed their Bachelor's degree, not more than in the last 6 years.

❖ DAAD scholarship stipend amount?

The monthly stipend you will receive will support your living expenses, health insurance, as well as travel expenses.

postgraduate students will be given a monthly stipend of 850 Euros.

- Postgraduate and Doctoral students will receive insurance and health coverage.
- Postgraduate and Doctoral students might receive a travel grant.
- Free accommodation in the university dorms will be part of the DAAD scholarship.

The Commonwealth Scholarship Commission in the UK (CSC) provides the UK government scholarship scheme led by international development objectives.

Commonwealth Master's Scholarships enable talented and motivated individuals to gain the knowledge and skills required for sustainable development, and are aimed at those who could not otherwise afford to study in the UK.

- **scholarship stipend amount?**

- Approved tuition fees: full fees are covered by an agreement between the CSC and the UK university, and scholars are not liable to pay for any part of the tuition fee
- Stipend (living allowance) at the rate of £1,236 per month, or £1,516 per month for those at universities in the London metropolitan area
- Warm clothing allowance, where applicable
- Thesis grant towards the cost of preparing a thesis or dissertation, where applicable
- Study travel grant towards the cost of study-related travel within the UK or overseas

❖ Italian Government Scholarship

The Italian government offers scholarships to foreign students and Italian citizens living abroad. The objective of this program is to strengthen international cooperation in the scientific, technological, cultural, and artistic fields and to promote the Italian language and culture.

Italian government scholarships are offered at the bachelor, master, and doctoral levels. Scholarships may also be awarded for research or linguistic stays in a public or legally recognized Italian institution.

Italy has one of the oldest universities in the world. It is known for its excellent higher education with low tuition fees. Admission to an Italian University is not hard. With 61 Vibrant Public Universities, 30 private universities, 11 public universities, and 339 courses held in English.

Financial Coverage

- **Tuition Fees:** Grantees may be exempted from the payment of enrolment and tuition fees depending on the policy of each University.
- **Health and Medical Insurance:** Grantees will be covered by health and medical/accident insurance contracted by MAECI for the entire duration of the grant.
- **Financial Grant:** Grantees will receive a 900 Euros monthly allowance on a quarterly basis, which will be paid to their Italian bank account.

❖ Chinese Government Scholarship (CSC)

Undergraduate / Bachelor's Program CSC Scholarship: CNY 2500 RMB Monthly Stipend, free tuition, and free accommodation

MS / Master Program Students CSC Scholarship: CNY 3000 RMB Monthly Stipend, free tuition, and free room.

Main thing:

1. Acceptance Letter:

Start Emailing now to Professors for Acceptance. Search professors profile related to your field of your desired university and send them emails and please don't copy email from others make it your own. Many of Chinese Universities preferred applicant having acceptance letter from university teacher where he/she is applying and some universities have no requirement of acceptance letter but if you have acceptance letter it is good symbol for you.

- Find out the Faculty List of targeted University/Universities.
- Find Professors which is matching with your field and Email him/her for acceptance letter.

Documents Required?

- ❖ DEGREE and TRANSCRIPT
- ❖ Letters of Recommendation
- ❖ Motivation Letter
- ❖ English Proficiency Letter
- ❖ CV in Europa's format for EUROPE scholarships Passport
- ❖ Any other documents you deem as important for your selection like experience
- ❖ certificates, projects, IELTS scores maybe if they are high, certificates,
- ❖ seminars/conferences/workshops attended, honours and awards, etc.



How to write good CV...

What is a CV?: CV highlights your skills, achievements and your goals. It sheds light on your past experience and how they prepare you for the present. In short, it's crucial to have a CV drafted, if you want to pursue a career regardless of the field.

1. Your Bio/ Intro: That is the easiest part but some important factors need to be considered. Make sure your Name is your Official Name. Write down your official email address, please keep your email address appropriate and official. Your current address, your Skype ID, Zoom ID and your active cell phone.

2. Professional Summary: It's important you have this section on your CV for it helps the recruiter to identify before reading your CV of your professional experience and your professional goals!

3. Work history : That's all the experience you have had working in xyz firms, working under professors as a RA, serving as a TA or GA. That's a very detailed and an elaborated part of the CV, make sure you write it clearly with enough detail.

4. Accomplishment: It's a very important section, do not undermine it, if you have accomplishments don't hesitate to mention. Mention any Research grant you won, any full-ride scholarships, any government funded scholarships, any high achievement award, anything that shows your high academic achievements!

NOTE: This list can go on depending upon your discipline and your occupation. These are just a few points to ensure to make a good CV! Don't make your CV long by adding unnecessary detail that is irrelevant.

How to write good Motivational Letter/ SOP

1. Who are you? What is your academic background?
2. Why did you choose what you are doing?
3. How did you get there?
4. What specific area you are interested in?
5. Do you have any research/practical experience in that area?
6. Did you find a university department or a professor in your area?
7. Why do you think this professor is a good match for you?
8. How did you find about the university/lab?
9. Why do you think the university and lab is a good match for you?
10. What is the professor doing currently in his research area?
11. What motivated you to choose that specific research area?
12. Where will this research lead you? What do you want to do with your PhD or Research Masters?
13. What skills would you bring to the program?
14. What are your short term and long-term plans?
15. Short term plans are right when you graduate and long-term plans would be where you see yourself 5-10 yrs after graduating?
