Afro Fovismo is another Almeida's perception of Afro-Brazilian culture, historically permeated by European influences.

Fovismo from the French Fauves is beyond an aesthetic reference and is an appropriate metaphor as Afro-Brazilian culture is anthropophagic and capable of digesting symbols of the most diverse forms of expression.

A great promoter of functional art in Brazil, Rodrigo Almeida's works are part of public and private collections like Center Georges Pompidou in France, MAD-NY, in Israel at the Design Museum Holon, and in the private collection of Li Edelkoort in Paris.
