





MY LIFE IS NO LONGER THE SAME – NOW THAT I’M LEARNING TO LIVE IT DIFFERENTLY - By Betty Rosse

For years, my job was to present information to senior adults about various topics on aging such as loneliness, sadness, grieving, anger, stress, positive thinking, and physical health. I delivered these topics based on what I called a “Wellness Thinking” format. In other words, I believe that how I think and feel about life and aging is directly related to how I decide to live it.

Society, our adult children and those in the health field like to tell us what we SHOULD do about aging, but what they say doesn’t always agree with what we want. I know that I am one of those seniors who do not want to be told what to do, but I’m smart enough to take it under advisement and then decide.

Many of us know WHAT to do, but not always HOW to do it. Since I’ve never been this age before, I’m learning as I go along. I’ve read that we don’t learn from what is being said, but from what we experience.

Now I’m beginning to practice what I have been preaching. Last year, after turning 70, I experienced some health problems, had surgery and was “slowed down” long

MI VIDA YA NO ES LA MISMA - AHORA QUE ESTOY APRENDIENDO A VIVIR DE OTRA MANERA - By Betty Rosse

Durante años, mi trabajo era presentar información a los adultos mayores sobre diversos temas de envejecimiento como la soledad, la tristeza, el duelo, la ira, el estrés, el pensamiento positivo y la salud física. Enseñe estos temas sobre una filosofía que llamo “pensamiento de bienestar”. En otras palabras, creo que la forma en que se piensa y se siente acerca de la vida y el envejecimiento, se relaciona directamente de cómo decido vivirla.

La sociedad, hijos y profesionales de la salud nos dicen lo que debemos hacer con respecto a la edad, pero lo que dicen no siempre coincide con lo que queremos. Soy una persona mayor que no quiere que se les diga qué hacer, pero soy lo suficientemente inteligente como para tomar sugerencias y luego decidir.

Muchos de nosotros sabemos qué hacer, pero no siempre cómo hacerlo. Como yo nunca he estado antes de esta edad, estoy aprendiendo sobre la marcha.

He leído que no aprendemos de lo que se dice, sino lo que se hace. Ahora estoy empezando a practicar mi filosofía. El año pasado, después de cumplir

I want to do what I've been doing – sharing my thoughts, ideas and possibilities with others, but with no restrictions concerning age, or topics. Fortunately, having met and gotten to know some wonderful people in the healthcare world, I was able to ask them for their input and their assistance along the way.

I resigned from my position as a Public Education Coordinator for Elderly and Veteran's Services a few months ago and am now "learning" to live my life differently. It's been seven weeks and WOW, what a difference each day makes. Since I don't have to get up to go to work, I can go to bed later, sleep later, eat when I want, watch the dust and clutter accumulate, do absolutely nothing and say to myself...I can do this again tomorrow! But, after a while, I find that's not working for me. Having worked for 55+ years, I've been conditioned to live a routine that was satisfying to me. At times though, it seems that I'm in a state of rebellion with my thoughts. "I don't have to if I don't want to," leaves me with feelings of ambivalence.

After talking to some friends about my thought contradictions, ranging from "WOW, I don't have to get up," to "Woe is me," to "What if everyone forgets me," just to name a few, I've decided it's all OK. So I'm giving myself permission to feel what I'm feeling. Leaving my world of work behind and starting on my new venture is an ending and also a beginning. So, I am now realizing and accepting that All is Well and I'm going to enjoy the ride!

I've scheduled a number of presentations for the next few months, planned a trip to visit a





PLAYING IT SAFE AT THE ATM

A motivated criminal only has to keep watch on an ATM for a short time to scope out the availability of a potential victim. As consumers, I remind you to always be cautious of your surroundings and conduct your business only in areas where you feel comfortable.

Due to the availability of surveillance cameras, ATMs at banks are typically the safest option, but that does not mean you have to steer clear of the ones at shopping malls, airports and sports venues. When you need to get cash, be sure to plan ahead before making an ATM withdrawal. If possible, always have someone with you. There are several safety tips you should follow to avoid becoming a victim at an ATM.

- Be aware of your surroundings when using an ATM. If you notice someone or something suspicious, do not stop to use it! Go to another ATM or return at a later time.

- Avoid using an ATM after dark. If you must, do so only in a well-lit area. Be mindful of tall or overgrown shrubbery and vegetation in the area.

Los cajeros automáticos (ATMs) son una gran comodidad, pero puede poner en peligro su seguridad. Un criminal sólo tiene que vigilar un cajero automático durante un tiempo corto hasta que este a su alcance una víctima potencial. Como consumidores, les recuerdo que siempre sean cautelosos, miren a sus alrededores y realicen su negocio sólo en las áreas donde se siente cómodo y seguro.

Debido a la disponibilidad de cámaras de vigilancia, los cajeros automáticos en los bancos suelen ser la opción más segura, pero eso no significa que no pueda utilizar los de los centros comerciales, los aeropuertos y los centros deportivos. Cuando usted necesite obtener dinero en efectivo, asegúrese de planificar con anticipación antes de hacer un retiro del cajero automático. Si es posible, que siempre haya alguien contigo. Hay varios consejos de seguridad que se deben seguir:

- Esté atento a sus alrededores cuando utilice un cajero automático. Si observa a alguien o algo sospechoso, no lo use! Vaya a otro cajero automático o regrese en un momento posterior.

- Evite el uso de un cajero automático por la noche. Si es necesario hacerlo hágalo sólo en un área bien iluminada. Considere si hay arbustos altos o maleza y vegetación en la zona.

- Have your card and any other documents you need ready when you approach an ATM. Fumbling with your wallet or purse makes you an easy target for thieves.

- When you use a drive-up ATM, be sure your passenger windows are closed and all doors are locked.

- When your transaction is finished, be sure you put your card, cash and receipt away before leaving the area.

- Do not display or count large amounts of cash in front of the ATM. Count your cash in the safety of your home or locked vehicle.

- If you are threatened for your money or your card by a thief, do not fight. Cash and cards are replaceable; your life is not.

- If at any time you need emergency assistance, do not hesitate to call 911.

While we all enjoy the convenience of today's technology, these conveniences can come at a price. When you're out getting cash this summer, the Broward Sheriff's Office reminds you to always be alert, be cautious and follow these tips to stay safe.

As a reminder, the Broward Sheriff's Office offers a free document shredding program to the public on the second Saturday of every month. For more information about our Shred-A-Thon program, or to download a copy of the upcoming schedule, please visit www.sheriff.org.

- Tenga su tarjeta y cualquier otro documento que necesite listo cuando se acerque a un cajero automático. Si manipula su billetera o cartera se convierte en un blanco fácil para los ladrones.

- Cuando use un ATM desde su automóvil, asegúrese de que las ventanas de los pasajeros y todas las puertas estén cerradas.

- Cuando la operación haya terminado, asegúrese de guardar su tarjeta, el dinero y el recibo antes de salir de la zona.

- No mostrar o contar grandes cantidades de dinero en frente de la ATM. Cuéntelo en su hogar o en su vehículo cerrado con llave.

- Si usted se ve amenazado por un ladrón, no pelee. Dinero en efectivo y tarjetas son reemplazables, su vida no lo es.



Mary Wilson is one of the founding members of the most successful women's vocal group in history, The Supremes. She was a member from its creation in 1961 until she went on her own in 1977 to launch a solo career. Ms Wilson is not only a successful performer, but also an author, a humanitarian and a Cultural Ambassador for the USA. We had the opportunity to spend time speaking with her about her life and we would like to share her thoughts with you.

55+ In 1959, at just 15 years of age, you started your singing career as a member of 'The Primettes.' Can you tell us about that part of your life?

MW I was still in Middle School when I had my first stage experience in a talent show. It was there I first met Florence Ballard and we became best friends and talked about joining a singing group. A couple of months later, she told me that some friends of hers were putting a group together. They had asked Betty Travis to join and wanted to know if I was interested also. Of course, I said YES! They then asked a girl across the street named Diana to join. That's how we got started in the music arena.

55+ The name of your group was changed in 1961 to 'The Supremes' and it became a trio. The Supremes had incredible success with 12 number one hits between 1964 and

55+ Later, the name of the group was changed to 'Diana Ross and The Supremes.' At the same time, Florence Ballard was replaced. What brought about these changes?

MW Well, it's like a progression of life. When a marriage starts, you are in love, but in time, problems start creeping in. It's wonderful if you can work those problems out, but sometimes you just can't. In our situation, we had grown up together, had dreams together and succeeded together. Then one person was not happy and one changed their mind and things started coming apart. As the last one standing, I had to decide if I wanted to go with other people in order to continue with the group. I did continue because I love doing this and I love being on stage.

55+ The Supremes continued to enjoy success after Diana Ross left the group. Was it hard to see her go after so many years?

MW It was hard to see Diana and Florence go. It was major for me. They were my best friends and I loved them both. And of course, they were the group. In the end, people have to figure out what's important to them. For me, at that time it was my survival.

55+ In 1977, after 16 years, you decided to leave The Supremes.

have become a pop singer was an accident in terms of choosing a career. I did not choose it as my career, it evolved into that.... and hey, IT WORKED!!! I had always been interested in acting as well. And now, in this stage of my life, I have just started taking acting classes again.

55+ “Dreamgirl: My Life as a Supreme” was a very successful book about the group in the 1960s. What made it so popular?

MW Well, hopefully because people were really interested in The Supremes. When I wrote the book, it was really written by a real Supreme, not just someone collecting all the clippings and putting it together. I kept diaries all my life so it was written from my first hand experience and my own viewpoint. It was an inside story and people were interested in the story behind the Supremes. If Diana had written it, it would have been from her viewpoint and it might have been very different. That’s just the way it is.

MW Every generation has its own music, even my parents. This is the music of this generation. If you look at ours, it was the music of my generation. Who am I to say that this music is not good, it is just different. For me, I still listen to Gladys Knight and the Pips, Nat King Cole, Johnny Mathis and so on. I do not pretend to be a critic of today's music. My favorite person singing today is Mariah Carey. I think she has a tremendous voice.

55+ In 1988, you represented The Supremes when you received the Lifetime Achievement Award with the group's induction into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame. And, in 1994, The Supremes were recognized with a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame. How did these recognitions make you feel?

MW It's all beautiful because it represents a life's work. You can look back and see that body of work and be proud that WOW, we really did achieve a great deal and inspired people along the way. That's the meaning behind it. In terms of my personal feelings, it was bittersweet because Florence and Diana were not there.

55+ In pursuing your solo career, is there a special moment that stands out as being very memorable for you?

MW It was kind of a new exploration, like going back to the beginning, starting all over again. It reminded me of when the three of us were just starting to find ourselves. I had not been the person

MW Todo es hermoso, ya que representa una vida de trabajo. Usted puede mirar atrás y ver el trabajo y estar orgullosos de que WOW realmente inspiró mucha gente a su paso. Ese es el significado de ello. En cuanto a mis sentimientos personales, fue agrí dulce porque Florence y Diana no estaban allí.

55+ En la búsqueda de tu carrera de solista, ¿hay un momento especial que se destaca por ser muy memorable para usted?

standing in front with the lyrics then. That was a new process I had to go through while I was touring in England and throughout Europe. It was a good time but it was also a scary time. I did not know if I was going to be able to do it. I had the desire and the ambition but I did not know if my voice quality would live up to the Mary Wilson of The Supremes era.

55+ Tell us about your “Dare to Dream” lecture series.

MW It came out of the loss of my son in a car accident and it was a time when I was doing a lot of interviews. I was being asked many questions regarding my son and the accident. I found that it was very helpful for people to hear me talk about my loss because people have a difficult time doing that. This evolved into groups asking me to lecture on this subject. I have lived a full life and I had written it all down in my books. I found myself with many subjects to talk about. It was all based on realism, things that really happened, and hopefully, I have helped other people from my experiences.

55+ You have remained very active in your 60s. Can you tell us your secret?

MW There is no secret. Just keep moving (laughs). I have a new single called ‘Life Has Been Good To Me.’ I am one of those people that just enjoys life. I love exploring and enjoying it. I’ve always had a dream of being an explorer or an inventor. I am in awe of life and all the things that are there. I like to explore it, I like to live it!

55+ You have been involved with many charities including UNICEF,

St Jude's Children's Hospital, the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation, and Humpty Dumpty Institute to name a few. Do you find this part of your life rewarding?

MW For the Humpty Dumpty Institute, originally being Princess Diana's project, I go around the world speaking about bombs that were dropped in countries like Vietnam, Laos, and Sri Lanka, and are laying there unexploded. People lose limbs when the bombs go off while they try to gather the scrap metal to sell it. It's great to be part of the world, part of human life, and do something other than for just yourself. It's a good feeling.

55+ In 2003, U.S. Secretary of State Colin Powell named you one of nine Cultural Ambassadors of the USA. How was that experience?

MW To have been chosen was a great honor because I remember that Louis Armstrong and Pearl Bailey were both Cultural Ambassadors when I was a young girl. I recall them speaking about what a privilege it was. I admired that, and when I was asked many years later, I could not believe it. I traveled with people from the government to all these countries around the world. One thing I noticed is that all the young people in these countries wanted to come to America.... that was their dream.

55+ You have also been very involved in how the fashions of The Supremes impacted social issues in the United States via the "The Story of the Supremes from the Mary Wilson Collection" Exhibition. Can you give us an update on this project?

MW It is called 'The Mary Wilson Gown Collection' It was in Great

MW Que se llama 'El vestido de la colección de María de Wilson' fue en Gran Bretaña en varios museos por dos años y medio. Se abrió aquí en el Rock and Roll Hall of Fame en Cleveland. Está de gira por Estados Unidos ahora y se prevé la apertura en enero en el Museo Afro-Americano en

Britain in various museums for two and a half years. It opened here at the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in Cleveland. It's touring around America now and opening in January at the Afro American Museum in Philadelphia and will be there for 6 months. It shows around 50 Supremes' gowns and a lot of memorabilia. It is so beautiful and these gowns have held up so well all these years. They were created by designers in America like Bob Mackey, Michael Travis and Jeffrey Holder. There are some earlier gowns from Motown that have disappeared. Some gowns have shown up here and there and I have no idea how people got them. I have actually bought some from Ebay and had some fans involved in helping me to get them. If anyone knows where some are, PLEASE LET ME KNOW.

55+ Thanks Mary Wilson for sharing her past and keeping us up to date on what is going on in her future. And our readers would just like to say, "Thanks for the music!"
