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

NEW TREATMENT FOR PSORIASIS AND VITILIGO

Summer has arrived and we are all looking forward to beach time, sandals and shorts! In this issue, I would like to share something with you that I have been experiencing since I was a child. As we age, as you know, we each have our own set of challenges....and mine is a skin disorder called Vitiligo. Skin conditions can really affect a person's life. You're probably familiar with Vitiligo because of the attention Michael Jackson brought to it. He suffered a loss of his skin pigmentation. Now, I am very excited to share my discovery of the latest treatment for Vitiligo and psoriasis.

Vitiligo is a skin condition in which there is a loss of pigment (color) from areas of the skin, resulting in irregular white patches that still feel like normal skin. An estimated 1 to 2 million Americans have Vitiligo. Although there is no cure, Vitiligo can be treated.

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
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While having fun with the family this summer, keep in mind that thieves and burglars don't take vacations from criminal activity. Stay vigilant

about protecting your home, your belongings and your identity. Don't let crime ruin your summer fun.

STAY ALERT. Be aware of what's going on in your neighborhood. Never hesitate to report suspicious activity to law enforcement. If you notice activity at your neighbors' house when you know they are away on vacation, call 911 immediately. Your tip might be the one that helps BSO detectives catch up to an otherwise elusive burglar. If you notice someone lurking around cars in a parking lot, phone in that tip. If you recognize a suspect from a surveillance video, call Crime Stoppers of Broward County. You may remain anonymous, and Crime Stoppers will pay up to \$1,000 for information leading to an arrest. Teaming up and keeping the lines of communication open between law enforcement and observant residents is the best defense against criminals.

Lock your doors and don't forget to arm your alarm systems if you

ESTÉ ALERTO. Sea consciente de lo que está pasando en su vecindario. Nunca dude en reportar cualquier actividad sospechosa a las autoridades. Si observa algo sospechoso en la casa de sus vecinos, llame al 911 inmediatamente. El punto es ayudar a los detectives del BSO a capturar un ladrón que de otro modo se haría difícil. Si observa a alguien merodeando por los automóviles en un estacionamiento, telefóne. Si usted reconoce a un sospechoso de un video de vigilancia, llame a Crime Stoppers del Condado de Broward. Usted puede permanecer en el anonimato, y Crime Stoppers pagará hasta \$ 1,000 por información que conduzca a un arresto. Trabajar en equipo y mantener las líneas de comunicación abiertas entre la policía y los residentes de observadores es la mejor defensa contra los criminales.

Cierre las puertas y no se olvide de activar los sistemas de alarma. Cuando está fuera de casa, cierre

have them. When you are out and about, lock your car doors and never keep valuables in plain view. It only takes a few seconds for a car burglar to grab your purse, wallet or cell phone from your car while you step away to walk your dog, pay for gas or put flowers at a gravesite. Don't make it easier for criminals by leaving a door unlocked.

Thinking of making some repairs before a hurricane approaches? Be wary of unlicensed contractors. They might take your money and run, do sub-standard work or have a criminal history. To make sure the workers in your home are licensed, visit the Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation's website at www.myfloridalicense.com.

Be suspicious of anyone who shows up uninvited at your door. Sometimes, criminals knock first, and they can be very charming. They might ask for a drink, for directions, to use the phone or say they were sent to do work at your house. These are common tactics of scam artists and thieves. If you don't know them, don't let them in.

Make your house look occupied when you are out. Leave a television or radio on, or set some lamps on timers. If you go away, stop your newspaper delivery and have someone collect your mail. You can even deter burglars with your landscaping. Plant some thorny bushes under windows that might make an illegal entry difficult. Trim back foliage that might block the view of your home from the street, and add some outdoor lighting so that criminals can't operate unnoticed.

Once you take the necessary precautions to protect yourself, your belongings and your family, you can relax and enjoy a fun and safe summer. •

Sospeche de cualquier persona que no conozca. A veces, los delincuentes a primera vista puede resultar encantadores. Pueden pedir una bebida, preguntar por direcciones, pedir usar el teléfono o dicen que fueron enviados a realizar trabajos en su casa. Estas son tácticas comunes de los estafadores y ladrones. Si no los esperaba, no los deje entrar!!!

Haga que su casa parezca ocupada cuando usted está fuera. Deje un televisor o radio encendido, o ponga algunas lámparas con temporizadores. Si usted se va, suspenda el reparto del periódico y que alguien recoja su correo. Plantar algunos arbustos espinosos debajo de ventanas puede hacer una entrada ilegal difícil. Recorte follaje que podría bloquear la vista de su casa desde la calle, y añadir un poco de iluminación al aire libre.

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
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As you prepare for this year's hurricane season, there may be something important you've missed. Do you have the Poison Control Hotline programmed into your cell phone? Storms and other natural disasters frequently lead to injuries, including poisonings.

Storm-related poisonings can include carbon monoxide exposure (from generators used improperly), medication mistakes, child poisonings, snake or insect bites, or poisoning from spoiled food. People with vision difficulties, chronic conditions or complex medication regimens can be at particular risk of poisoning. People over 65 are also the demographic group in the U.S. who are least likely to know about the free services of poison control centers. By taking a moment to program 1-800-222-1222 into your cell phone, you'll ensure you have immediate access to the doctors, nurses and pharmacists at South Florida's poison control center at Jackson Memorial Hospital/University of Miami Medical Center. Even after a serious storm, if you have a working phone, you can reach a poison expert for free and confidential help, 24 hours, seven days a week. Take a moment to program your phone, and visit the Florida Poison Information Center-Miami website at www.miamipoison.org for more information. •



Mientras se prepara para la temporada de huracanes de este año, puede haber algo importante que se le haya escapado.

¿Tiene el número de teléfono de Control de envenenamientos programado en su celular? Las tormentas y otros desastres naturales a veces conducen a lesiones, incluyendo las intoxicaciones.

Envenenamientos relacionados con tormentas pueden incluir la exposición a monóxido de carbono (generadores utilizados indebidamente), errores de medicación, picaduras de insectos o serpientes, o la intoxicación por alimentos en mal estado. Las personas con dificultades de visión, problemas crónicos o regímenes complejos de medicación son más propensos para los envenenamientos. Las personas mayores de 65 años también tienen menos probabilidades de saber acerca de los servicios gratuitos de los centros de control de intoxicaciones. Al programar el 1-800-222-1222 en su celular se asegura de tener acceso inmediato a los médicos y farmacéuticos del centro de control de toxicología del Hospital Jackson Memorial. Incluso después de una tormenta seria, si usted tiene un teléfono que funcione, puede contactarlos para obtener ayuda gratuita y confidencial, 24/7. Más información en www.miamipoison.org. •

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DO YOU HAVE AN UNDETECTED VISION PROBLEM?

¿TIENE USTED UN PROBLEMA DE VISIÓN NO DETECTADO?

Few people realize that even if they test 20/20 on an eye chart during a routine exam, they may still have undetected vision problems that are often misdiagnosed and severely reduce their enjoyment of life and even contribute to falls.

Symptoms typically include swerving off course even when you think you're walking a straight line, seeing words "jump around" on a page when you're reading, finding yourself unable to pour a beverage without missing the cup, and tripping on chair legs.

The reasons for those problems travel under fancy names such as convergence insufficiency, binocularity problems, visual midline shift syndrome, and impaired peripheral vision. They are often associated with people who have experienced a stroke or head injury.

Few optometrists are trained to recognize such problems. However, even the U.S. Army in February recognized the impact undetected vision problems can have on returning soldiers and instituted a program to check for them.

In rehabilitation settings, it's particularly important to make sure that as part of your therapeutic recovery plan your vision isn't overlooked. Whitehall Boca Raton recently launched its own functional vision rehab program, which is led by world-renowned neuro-optometrist

Pocas personas se dan cuenta que incluso si la prueba es 20/20 en una tabla optométrica durante un examen rutinario, todavía pueden tener problemas no detectados de la visión que a menudo son mal diagnosticados contribuyendo a posibles caídas.

Los síntomas suelen incluir desviarse de su curso, incluso cuando crees que estás caminando por una línea recta, al ver las palabras "saltar" de una página que estás leyendo, encontrarse a sí mismo incapaz de verse una bebida sin perder la copa, y tropezar con uno de patas de la silla.

Las razones de esos problemas pueden ser por la insuficiencia de convergencia, problemas de binocularidad, el síndrome visual de desplazamiento de línea media, y el deterioro de la visión periférica. A menudo se asocian con personas que han sufrido un accidente cerebrovascular o la cabeza.

Pocos optometristas están capacitados para reconocer estos tipos de problemas. Sin embargo, incluso el Ejército de los EE.UU. en febrero reconoció los problemas de visión no detectados que puede tener los soldados que regresan de la guerra e instituyó un programa para detectar este problema.

En los centros de rehabilitación, es particularmente importante asegurarse de que, como parte de su plan de recuperación

Dr. Larry Lampert. He noted that recent studies show at least 35 percent of the elderly population have binocular vision problems and may be experiencing falls as a result.

He advises anyone with persistent vision problems to seek an optometrist able to diagnose and prescribe proper treatment for those issues. •



terapéutica que su visión no se pasa por alto. Whitehall Boca Raton ha lanzado recientemente su propio programa de rehabilitación funcional de la visión, liderada por el mundialmente conocido neuro-optometrista el Dr. Larry Lampert. Señaló que estudios recientes demuestran que al menos el 35 por ciento de la población de edad avanzada tienen problemas de visión binocular y puede estar experimentando caídas como consecuencia de ello.

said, “Don’t you think you have this a little bit reversed? Don’t you think it should be Mommy and Daddy (people), then money, then things?” Then she said “YEAH!” That’s EXACTLY how it started. Just that simple.

55+ In the last few years you have been named as one of the most influential people in the world by several top magazines. How does this make you feel?

SO Hmm.... very satisfied, but not for the reason you might think. It was those same magazines that wrote some of the most absolutely, horrific articles on me. Those exact, same magazines made fun of me when I first started. They asked what a woman, who did not have any type of financial degree, who talked about spirituality and money, who talked to minorities rather than the majority, and talked about money having an energy force of its own...what would she know about anything? The magazines would call me “Suze the Floozie” or Suze with nothing more than just hype. Why are we all listening to her anyway? Are you kidding? And now, a few years later, those exact same magazines name me as one of the most influential people in the world, or one of the top 100 women in the world. 55+ Prepaid cards have become very important in the market and I noticed that “The Approved Card from Suze Orman” was listed as one of the 5 best cards due to its low fees. Please tell us about the benefits of this card?

SO If they really understood that card, they would always rank it as number one. To live in today’s world, you need a piece of plastic. There are 70 million people currently that are using prepaid cards and it is projected to be 120 million in the next few years. What is so sad is that the majority of the cards, in my opinion, charge people way too much money. They give you no benefits and no services. You have to pay a lot of fees for using those cards. I decided that I needed to do something about it and I put in over \$1 million of my own money. I created The Approved Card. The name came from the ‘Can I afford it?’ segment. I believe it is one of the lowest, if not the lowest cost card in the market. When it first came out, many people lied about it. You also get benefits like identity theft protection free, unlimited TransUnion credit reports, credit monitoring, a text or email when you charge something to the card, and you can pay your bills online free. If people use it the way I tell them to use it, they would not pay more than \$3 a month. This card will be everything that you would want it to be.

SO My years have given me a maturity that only years can give. It has made me not so vulnerable or sensitive to what others say. It has given me a conviction in the work that I have done and only made me




more complex and not only the answers... but the questions to be asked....will be very different.
