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

In December I had the pleasure of speaking at the Annual Volunteer Recognition Luncheon for the Alzheimer's Family Center. This not-for-profit organization has the most active and proactive volunteers and programs dedicated to improve the lives of families affected by Alzheimer's and other memory disorders.

The commitment and dedication of these volunteers was recognized by their staff and supporters. I had the honor of addressing many of the volunteers involved in the Companionship Program. These trained volunteers visit families that are caring for someone with Alzheimer's disease at home for a few hours each week. This service is available to families living anywhere in Broward County.

Other programs and services provided by the Center include In-Home Respite Care (a trained aide relieves the caregiver for a minimum of 4 hours each week); Case Management; In-Home Counseling (a trained counselor meets with the caregiver to help reduce stress, anxiety and to deal with issues related to caregiver's responsibilities); information and referrals with questions about Alzheimer's disease; and services available in the community for persons with the disease and others affected by it. All of their services are offered free of charge.

Alzheimer's Family Center and their volunteers are an example of how to live well at any age. •

Otros programas y servicios incluyen In Home Care (un ayudante entrenado que alivia al cuidador por un mínimo de 4 horas a la semana), Manejo de casos, Consejería en el Hogar (un consejero se reúne para ayudar a reducir el estrés, la ansiedad y para tratar asuntos relacionados con los cuidados), información y referencia sobre la enfermedad y servicios disponibles para el cuidador y el paciente. Estos servicios son gratuitos.

Alzheimer's Family Center y sus voluntarios son ejemplos de cómo vivir bien a cualquier edad. •



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
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
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# SAGE OPENS NEW SENIOR CENTER

## SAGE ABRE CENTRO PARA RETIRADOS

In 2012 in New York City, Services and Advocacy for Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual and Transgender Elders (SAGE) will open the nation's first full-time senior center for older adults.

Drawing on SAGE's 32 years of experience in designing programs for LGBT elders, the center will partner with community organizations in the five boroughs to extend affirming services to LGBT older New Yorkers who do not regularly access their local senior centers for fear of discrimination, and to those who may not know of SAGE's current services. "SAGE is honored to have this opportunity to strengthen the programs and services we offer to address the unique needs of LGBT older people in New York City," said Michael Adams, Executive Director of SAGE. "Opening The SAGE Center has been our dream for many years. We are thrilled to be part of a bold initiative that emphasizes innovation in aging services"

The SAGE Center is part of New York City's Innovative Senior Center program, a new initiative by Mayor Michael Bloomberg to create centers that address the needs of historically underserved elder populations, with creative needs-based programming that will serve as models for the "senior center of the future."

The new center will offer hot meals as well as programs covering issues from health and wellness to workplace skills, comprehensive social services, a wide range of social activities, and much more. •

Crime as we know it is not a new phenomenon, but the types of crimes being committed are starting to change with the availability of new technology

and easily accessible personal information. One such crime called the “Grandparent Scam” has resulted in the financial exploitation and victimization of many unsuspecting victims.

The scam involves instances where a person claiming to be a family member or close personal friend contacts the victim by phone or e-mail. The scammer fabricates a compelling story suggesting that he or she is in some type of trouble and needs immediate financial assistance. To help validate their story, the scammer is able to obtain personal information about the victim or the victim’s family through public data found on the internet or by hacking into the victim’s e-mail account.

Typically, the scammer will ask that you wire money immediately. Unfortunately, once the scam has been committed and money has been exchanged, there is very little that law enforcement can

do. The crime as we know it, no longer is a new phenomenon, but the types of crimes that are being committed are starting to change with the availability of new technology and easily accessible personal information. One such crime called the “Grandparent Scam” has resulted in the financial exploitation and victimization of many unsuspecting victims.

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do because the perpetrator most often lives overseas. Even if you are wiring money to a location in the United States, the wire transfer immediately bounces to a location outside of the country.

A common tactic is when the scammer indicates a friend or family member has legal trouble or is in the hospital and in desperate need of medical attention. These are only a few scenarios used by scammers, but detectives from the Broward Sheriff's Office have heard many more.

The most important thing we all can do is pass this information along to our friends, family and co-workers so they are aware of this common scam and could be a potential target. If you are ever contacted by a friend or family member in trouble, follow these important steps before providing any financial assistance:

- Stop and ask yourself if this person or family member would contact you in such a crisis.
- Make contact with other relatives or friends to verify the status and whereabouts of the person contacting you.
- Trust your gut instinct. If something does not seem right or is out of the ordinary, it is most likely a con. •

Si alguna vez se contacta con un amigo o miembro de la familia en problemas, siga estos pasos importantes antes de proporcionar cualquier asistencia financiera:

- Pare y piense si esta persona o miembro de la familia en contacto con usted esta en una crisis.
- Póngase en contacto con otros familiares o amigos para verificar el estado y el paradero de la persona en contacto con usted.
- Confíe en su instinto. Si algo no está bien o está fuera de lo común, lo más probable es que sea un engaño. •

**55+** Tell us about your parents and how you related to them in your early years in Brooklyn?

**LG** It was not only my parents, it was a complete family. I was the first one born up north. We were from Georgia. Our whole family did not live more than 10 to 15 blocks from one another. I was an only child but I was raised with many cousins. The older women from the family, starting with my great-grandmother, took care of the children. It was complete care for one another. My older cousins took care of me and I took care of my younger ones. We were together almost all of the time and Christmas, Thanksgiving and Easter were the best times of all! I can picture all of us sitting around the table and eating together. We were a family of people and the neighborhood was pretty much like that too. I wish America were like that again today.

**55+** You lived a protected childhood with not only very protective and loving parents but also relatives, neighbors and


**55+** Háblenos de tus padres y cómo lo relacionado con ellos en sus primeros años en Brooklyn?

**LG** No se trataba sólo de mis padres, era una familia completa. Yo fui el primero en nacer en el norte. Estábamos en Georgia. Toda nuestra familia vivía a no más de 10 a 15 cuadras el uno del otro. Yo era hijo único, pero me crié con muchos primos. Las mujeres mayores de la familia, comenzando con mi bisabuela, se hacían cargo de los niños. Fue un cuidado completo del uno al otro. Mis primos mayores me cuidaban y yo me hacía cargo de mis primos más jóvenes. Estuvimos juntos casi todo el tiempo en Navidad, Acción de Gracias y Semana Santa. Fueron los mejores momentos de todos! Recuerdo a todos sentados a la mesa y comiendo juntos. Éramos una familia y el barrio era muy parecido a eso. Desearía que nuestro país fuera así de nuevo hoy.

friends. How did that play a part in putting together the person you would become as an adult?

**LG** Well, it formed a great security blanket around me. Whether you were Irish, Jewish, Black, Filipino or Italian, we took care of one another both in our schools and in our neighborhood. It was right after the Depression and I remember that the toys were incredible! We would take a broomstick and make it a bat. When we played cops and robbers or cowboys, we would use our fingers to point at people and

pero también familiares, vecinos y amigos. ¿Qué papel jugaron en la elaboración del adulto que es hoy?

**LG** Bueno, se formó una gran manta de seguridad alrededor mío. Irlandés, judío, Negro, filipino o el italiano, nos hacíamos cargo unos de otros, tanto en nuestras escuelas como en nuestro vecindario. Fue justo después de la depresión y recuerdo que los juguetes eran increíbles! Nos gustaba tener un palo de escoba y convertirlo en un bate. Cuando jugamos a policías y ladrones o vaqueros, podíamos utilizar nuestros dedos para señalar a la gente y decir “¡Bang! Bang! ¡Estás muerto!” Era nuestro sistema de creencias 100%. Tuvimos profesores que nos enseñaron que no hay nada imposible. Lo que estaba en la televisión y en las películas era edificante en esos momentos.

**55+** Usted ha conocido a gente increíble en su vida. ¿Cuáles dos han hecho el mayor impacto en usted y cómo?

**LG** El primero tiene que ser mi bisabuela. Ella era una esclava. Ella debería tener alrededor de 7 años de edad cuando los esclavos fueron liberados, y ella aún estaba viva cuando hice mi primera obra de teatro. Ella falleció a los 109 años. Mi segundo impacto, afuera de mi empresa, sería mi profesor de inglés, Gustav Blumberg. Estuvo en el teatro europeo y más tarde se convirtió en un director-escritor. Miraba los ofrecimientos diarios y un día me dijo, “están

say “Bang! Bang! You’re dead!” Our belief system was 100%. We had teachers that taught us that there was no such thing as impossible. What was on television and films was uplifting at that time.

**55+ You have met some incredible people in your life. Which two would you say have made the biggest impact on you and how?**

**LG** The first one has to be my great-grandmother. She was a slave. She must have been around 7 years old when the slaves were freed, and she was still alive to watch me do my first play. She passed away when she was 109. My number two person, outside of the business, would be my English teacher, Gustav Blumberg. He was in the European theater and later became a director-writer. He watched the trades daily and one day he said, “they are looking for a kid to do a Broadway show. Tell your mother to take you down there.... what do you have to lose?” I would like to see more of that in America. I have a foundation with all these philosophies, based on the way I was raised. This is the way we should be living in this country. When people came to America and entered through Ellis Island, they were welcomed in our neighborhoods with open arms. This is the reason people came here in the first place; this is supposed to be the promised land. And this is the promised land. We cannot take that for granted.

**55+ After your father passed away, your mom came to live with you for some time. How was that experience for you?**

**LG** It was wonderful. My mom and I were able to relate to each other as grown-ups. My mom had a little bout with cancer that was not

**55+ Después de que su padre falleció, su madre vino a vivir con usted por algún tiempo. ¿Cómo fue esa experiencia para usted?**

**LG** Fue maravilloso. Mi mamá y yo fuimos capaces de relacionarnos como adultos. Mi madre tuvo un cáncer que no era maligno. Ella vino a mi casa en el campo, parecido al mismo lugar donde se crió en Georgia. Vivió durante dos años. Pero como echaba de menos los gritos de los niños en la calle, la dejé volver a casa. La pasamos bien juntos.

**55+ Usted creció en Coney Island, donde tenía muchos amigos y vecinos de diferentes orígenes. Crecer en un ambiente tan diverso, en el que aprendió a respetar a todo tipo de personas, debe haber sido doloroso para usted ser víctima de la discriminación en su vida, de acuerdo con lo que escribió en su libro. Cuéntenos acerca de eso.**

**LG** Instalo una semilla de duda en mi sistema. Cuando no podía actuar o comportarme de la manera que lo hice en mi infancia o en mis primeros 25

malignant. She came to my home in the countryside, like where she was raised in the country in Georgia. What it did was extend her life for two years. But she missed the screaming at the kids in the street, like a grandmother and after two years, I let her go back home. We had a good time together.

**55+** You grew up in Coney Island where you had many friends and neighbors from many different backgrounds. Growing up in such a diverse environment, where you learned to respect all kinds of people, it must have been painful for you to experience discrimination later in life, according to what you wrote in your book. Tell us about that.

**LG** It caused a seed of doubt to grow in my system. When I could not act or behave the way I did in my childhood or for my first 25 years of life, it was hard. We lived and partied together, we had successes and disappointments together. The workers that formed the fabric and the backbone of Los Angeles did not come from the background that I did. They were forced psychologically not to behave the way we did back east. That caused a hot pill in my stomach and in order to make it there, I had to force myself NOT to behave the same way I did in New York. That was necessary in order to be successful. Over the long run, it could have been a psychological mistake. I do not do that today because I believe that the way I was when I was young, the way we were together when I was young, is the way we should be today across this country.


**55+** The demands of your career sacrificed your happiness many



años de vida, fue difícil. Vivimos y disfrutamos juntos, hemos tenido éxitos y decepciones juntos. Los trabajadores y la columna vertebral de Los Ángeles no tienen mis antecedentes. Se vieron obligados psicológicamente a comportarse de manera distinta a los que lo hicimos en el este. **LG** Esa es una pregunta difícil. Hacer una película requiere el mismo día de 10 horas como ser un taxista o un hombre de la basura, las mismas horas, la misma devoción. Usted tiene que traer el dinero para asegurarse

**LG** That's a tough one. It's a tall order. Making a movie requires the same 10-hour day like being a taxi driver or a garbage man, the same hours, the same devotion. You have to bring in the money to make sure that the rest of the family is taken care of. Your family needs to understand that this is the case in many situations and overcome it. It does not happen all the time but when it does, it's a beautiful thing.

**55+ How is your relationship with your sons today?**

**LG** They are both fantastic. They were at my house just the other day... the whole family was.

**55+ Winning the Academy Award for Best Supporting Actor for your role in 'An Officer and A Gentleman' was a great achievement for you. Tell us about that?**

**LG** Well, it made history. I was the first African-American man to win an Oscar. Sidney Poitier was the first black man to win an Oscar, but he is from the Bahamas. Good stuff came from it but many things that I expected to come from it did not

happen. It did not bear that much weight. I had to wait for a year to get proper work. And I have never made a great deal of money from my movies, but I have had quite an accomplished career and I am very satisfied with it. Before that movie, I had won an Emmy for my work in 'Roots.' That established me on television.

**55+** Since your book title is similar to the name of this movie, do you personally think that this is the role that your fans will most remember you by?

**LG** I think so. It hit the world pretty strong. Everywhere I go it has a nice fan base.

**55+** You have won numerous other awards for your exemplary work. Does one specific award stand out besides the Academy Award?

**LG** Well, there are two. The Golden Globe, which is the foreign press, and I have 3 of those. And, of course, the NAACP Image Award. My people are very proud of what I have done. Those two are invaluable to me.

**55+** You founded the Eracism Foundation in 2006. Tell us how that came about and what the foundation is doing today?

**LG** It comes out of my personal experience of being a black man with success and still not having the keys to the kingdom. It's overwhelming to try to change everybody. But if you can, start the way I started as a child, with the experiences that I have had with so many different people. Teach the children how to experience this at a young age, then it will be there when they grow up. Take a little slice from each of the different neighborhoods and show them

'who has the most money.' That has nothing to do with why this country was started. That's my little contribution to it. It's a play on words 'erace racism.'

**55+** Do you have any suggestions for our 55+ readers as to how they should approach the future?

**LG** All they have is really today. You need to make a choice about what you want to do today. Make it a point to help someone you do not even know. Help someone to cross the street. You have to take better care of yourself. You have to know that God is in charge all the time and you need to get as close to Him as possible on a daily basis. He will give you instructions on what to do to make this world better.

**55+** Your book certainly made an impact on this fan of yours. Are there chapters still to be written? What would they be about?

**LG** I am starting another book. It's a continuum called 'For What It's Worth.' The way you hear me speaking now, but more specifics. Why it is important that we take care of this planet, number one, and that we take better care of our children. We do not cheat one another, we need to take better care of one another -- whether they are part of our family or not. That is the key to our success as a people. That is the charm of America, it's all written. We must behave that way. •

Los servicios incluyen la organización de la casa de objetos personales y muebles; tasadores, agentes de bienes raíces, y compañías de mudanzas, reparaciones del hogar, y el mantenimiento del césped, piscina y de la propiedad durante la venta de la casa.

“A veces los miembros de la familia viven lejos y nos necesitan sólo para controlar la propiedad”, dijo McCarty. “Yo puedo manejar tanto o tan poco como ellos quieren y facilitar lo que quieren hacer”. •





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

To this day she visits nursing homes keeping up her drive to make things better for the Alzheimer's victim and their caregivers.

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

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
