## **INDOOR RANGE PROCEDURES**

(Rules of Conduct on the Range)

- 1. Range fee must be paid and log book must be signed before entering the range to shoot.
- 2. Eye and ear protection are mandatory in the range.
- 3. ABSOLUTELY NO HANDLING OF FIREARMS WHILE PEOPLE ARE DOWN RANGE.
- 4. Do not display firearms outside of the Ready Room and range.
- 5. Members are responsible for their guests.
- 6. Automatic firearms and any rifle over .22 caliber rim-fire is STRICTLY PROHIBITED Use of jacket and range-safe ammo is now <u>preferred</u>, although lead is acceptable. Tracer, frangible, and armor-piercing rounds are STRICTLY PROHIBITED.
- 7. Obey all Range Master commands Do not enter the range until authorized.
- 8. Load only 5 rounds per magazine or cylinder at a time.
- 9. Fire only at assigned targets.
- 10. Targets may not be placed closer than 25 feet from the shooting stations.
- 11. Shoot only from stations: absolutely no shooting in front of the firing line.
- 12. Notify the Range Master or Club Officer of malfunctions or any accident immediately and await instructions.
- 13. Keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to fire.
- 14. Smoking is prohibited anywhere on the range.
- 15. Food and beverages are prohibited in the range.
- 16. Police the range before leaving.
- 17. Any infraction of club rules and regulations will result in disciplinary action.
- 18. The use of black powder is not allowed.
