## 2016 Community Class Offerings



Hannah Baumgarten of Dance Now Miami Intermediate/Advanced Contemporary Ballet Based Class Sunday, January 17, 2016 from 2:00 - 3:30 Mercyhurst University (Dance Space)

Hannah Baumgarten grew up between Santa Cruz, California, and Jerusalem, Israel where she began her dance training. Hannah received a B.F.A from the Juilliard School after attending the University of Utah Ballet Department and is a winner of the Florida Choreographic Fellowship; her work has been presented internationally and nationally in ten states; she has taught

throughout the US and abroad. Hannah danced with Utah Ballet, Michael Uthoff DanceTheatre, Labyrinth Dance Theatre, William Adair and Dancers, Karen Peterson & Dancers, Momentum Dance Company, Giovanni Luquini & Dancers and Ballet Flamenco La Rosa. While at Juilliard, Hannah danced lead roles in the works of Master Choreographers such as Graham, Limon, Taylor, Sokolow, Harkarvy and Nikolais and had her choreography presented at several venues in Lincoln Center. She founded Dance NOW! Miami with Diego Salterini, and through Dance NOW! has toured the US from New York to Arizona, Central America and conducted residencies in and South America. Hannah Directed the Magnet High School Dance Program at Dillard Center for the Arts in Ft. Lauderdale for 10 years and currently serves as adjunct faculty at the Academy of Arts & Minds High School. Ms. Baumgarten is certified in Pilates through Core Dynamics and has served as a grant panelist for the State of Florida and Miami-Dade Departments of Cultural Af-fairs. Baumgarten has been on faculty at the Interlochen Summer Camp since 2005 and the Joffrey Ballet School NY Summer Program since 2012.



Barbara Sandonato was a celebrated leading dancer and now a nationally esteemed Master Teacher. Ms. Sandonato trained at the Lorna London School of Ballet in Larchmont, NY and received a scholarship to study at the School of American Ballet. She was the first dancer to join Barbara Weisberger at the Pennsylvania

Ballet as it formed in 1962. Ms. Sandonato remained Principal Dancer with that company until 1977, except for a one-year stint with the National Ballet of Canada where, as a principal, she performed with Rudolf Nureyev. She won the Bronze medal at the prestigious Fifth International Ballet Competition in Varna, Bulgaria in 1970.

In great demand as a teacher, Ms. Sandonato has taught at the University of the Arts, Point Park University, SUNY Purchase and Barnard College. She has also been on the faculty of the Pennsylvania Ballet, Central Pennsylvania Youth Ballet, Ballet Academy East, STEPS on Broadway, Alvin Ailey American Dance Centre, Philadanco, Princeton Ballet, Stamford City Ballet School, and Pittsburgh Ballet Theatre School.



Elec Simon has been influencing both aspiring and established musicians of every age for most of his life. From early childhood on, this self-taught musician and tap dancer has viewed everything around him as an instrument for sharing his passion for music and percussion. In 2005 Elec first joined the

professional realm as a cast member of the critically acclaimed Broadway production of STOMP where he still performs occasionally on tour. In 2005 Elec also performed in Tap Extravaganza in NYC, along with Savion Glover, whose performance in Bring in Da Noise Bring in Da Funk inspired Elec to embark on a life of dance and percussion.

As a percussionist, Elec has been invited to sit in at several legendary Harlem jazz clubs, including St. Nick's Pub, Minton's Playhouse and Lennox Lounge, where he has jammed alongside jazz artists Patience Higgins, Andy McLeod, and Dave Gibson. Elec has also accompanied funk master Justin Miles and hip hop artist Ace Boogie as the percussionist on recent recordings.



Tomé Cousin - An "interdisciplinary artist", heavily influenced by his eclectic range of creative mentors. As a result he has molded an award winning international career that includes collaborations in dance, theater, music, film, photography, television and literature. He holds a Bachelors of Arts in

Dance History and Choreography from Point Park University and a Masters of Fine Art in New Media Art and Performance from Long Island University. Additionally he studied at the Museum of Fine Arts (Baltimore), TheBauhaus School (Dessau, Germany), The Alvin Ailey School of American Dance, and The Martha Graham School.

For nine seasons Tomé appeared as "Ragdoll Tomé" on PBS' award winning children's program Mr. Rogers Neighborhood. Other television appearances include: Sesame Strasse (Germany), Flitterabend (Germany), The Tonight Show with Jay Leno (NBC), The Rosie O'Donnell Show (ABC), The Today Show (NBC), The 2000 Tony Awards (CBS), The Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade (NBC) and Contact Live From Lincoln Center (PBS - 2003 Emmy Award Best Live Entertainment).

His dance credits include The Physical Theater Project (Co founder /Artistic Director), Pina Bausch's Tanztheater Wuppertal (Germany), Bill T. Jones and Arnie Zane Co in collaboration with graffiti artist Keith Haring, Ballett Bern (Switzerland), and The American Dance Ensemble.
