### The Trust

The Lincolnshire Chalk Stream Trust (LCST) is a Charitable Incorporated Organisation established in 2019. We are a registered charity with a Board of Trustees working to;

- 1) To promote for the benefit of the public the recovery, conservation, protection and improvement of the physical and natural environment by promoting the biological diversity of the chalk streams, blow wells and related features in Lincolnshire focussed around the Lincolnshire Wolds, North Lincolnshire and North East Lincolnshire.
- 2) To advance the education of the public in the recovery, conservation, protection and improvement of the physical and natural environment of chalk streams, blow wells and related features.

Our work complements that of the Lincolnshire Chalk Streams Project Partnership.

Some knowledge of the chalk streams habitats, or ecology in general is desirable though not essential, as is a broad knowledge of the area – we are more interested in hearing from anyone with a keenness to help and broad background skills, who can help to steer the charity into the future.

### Location

The LCST head office is kindly hosted by the Lincolnshire Wolds Countryside Service who manage the Lincolnshire Wolds National Landscape and host the Lincolnshire Chalk Stream Project staff, based in the attractive market town of Louth.

The majority of our meetings (approximately 3-4 meetings a year) are held online so proximity to the office is not a requirement of joining our Board of Trustees. Face to face meetings can be requested if desired, as can site visits with the Lincolnshire Chalk Streams Project partnership to view current and past project sites, so ability to travel occasionally would be beneficial.
