- What is Boys 2 MEN/Girls 2 Women? A community non-profit organization with a mission of keeping children 1) In school, 2) Off drugs, 3) Out of gangs and 4) Teen pregnancy prevention.
- How does the Boys 2 MEN/Girls 2 Women program work?

We will help your child(ren) keep up their grades and communicate with their teacher to make sure they are not missing assignments. Tutors/Mentors will help them meet grade level in Math and English. This program is essential with the help from our partnerships between schools and local community resources to provide literacy, academic enrichment, and safe constructive assistance for students in kindergarten through twelfth grade (K–9). With children behind on course work, our mission is to keep children from "Falling through the Cracks (FTC)".

How are children referred? Children are referred by their teachers, school managers, principals, social workers, foster care agencies and family members. Once we explain to the schools about our goal of reaching out to students, the school administrators generally waste no time in developing lists, since these children are quite easy. to identify

✓ How do I become involved? There are three (3) ways to take part — by giving one or all of what we call the three "T's."

#### **After School Tutoring**

B2M/G2W will work with children to establish weekly progress reports as they are tutored two to three days per week. Each child will be assigned a mentor who will encourage and tutor the child throughout a semester.

Supporting them throughout the school year.

### **Mentoring**

We start by partnering with universities, colleges and junior colleges by establishing federal work studies contracts in order to recruit, hire and train mentors to work with the students at the elementary and secondary schools surrounding the colleges.

#### **Educational**

These college students will examine the elementary and secondary schools while following all the procedures required in order to become legal volunteers with B2MG2W. Once the college students become volunteers, their goal will be to identify what Boys 2 MEN/-Girls 2 Women calls "Falling Through the Crack" (FTC) children. Our goal is to avoid children from "Falling through the cracks".

#### **College Students' Mission**

Once our college students become volunteers and then learn to identify the child's needs, they begin mentoring/tutoring through our free after school program. It will be established in our facility, on or near the children's campus, utilizing campus classrooms, cafeterias or libraries. Off-campus libraries and community centers are an option, as well.
