TRIP SNAPSHOT:

Day 1 – Saturday, 10/04/2025 – Travel to your overnight hotel.

Day 2 - Sunday, 10/05/2025 - Travel to your overnight hotel.

Day 3 – Monday, 10/06/2025 – Arrive in Portland, Maine's largest city-by-the-sea. Enjoy a Welcome Reception by our Lobsterette upon arrival. She'll provide a souvenir Lobster Hat for each passenger and walking maps for the villages you'll visit.

Day 4 – Tuesday, 10/07/2025 – Tour historic Portland! Have a photo stop at Portland Head lighthouse – Maine's oldest and the most photographed; drive by Spring Point Lighthouse, perched out in the harbor on a granite jetty and the nearby Bug Lighthouse Park on the grounds of a former



shipyard with WWII Liberty Ship. Travel to Freeport – home to the LL Bean flagship store. Tour the Maine Lighthouse Museum. Travel "downeast" and cross the causeway to Mt. Desert Island, named for its bare, desert-like mountaintops on the edge of the ocean.

Day 5 – Wednesday, 10/08/2025 – Enjoy a narrated tour of Acadia National Park, the first park founded east of the Mississippi – The tour includes the stunning **Loop Road**, the summit of **Cadillac Mountain**, the crashing waves at **Thunder Hole**, and the quiet beauty of the inland park. Travel to **Wreaths Across**

America in Maine's blueberry and balsam region along the "Sunrise Coast". Take a guided tour profiling the wreath-laying ceremonies that take place each December at **Arlington National Cemetery**. Learn how a 12-year-old Bangor Daily Newspaper boy's trip to Washington DC laid the groundwork for an annual event to honor the graves of US veterans.

<u>Day 6 – Thursday, 10/09/2025</u> – Travel to the South Coast Maine Area, famous for its stretches of sandy beaches and salt air breezes. Travel to Kennebunkport – with its many charming shops and eateries in Dock Square. Then board an oversized lobstering tour boat for Lobstering Cruise. Learn how the Maine lobstermen make their living as traps are hauled from the ocean along the rocky coast of Kennebunkport. See the sights as you cruise on the ocean past Walkers Point, the 'Dark Shadows House' and Bumpkin Island, home to a year-round colony of sea birds and seals.



Day 7 – Friday, 10/10/2025 – Travel to your overnight hotel. After breakfast, make your way home with your magical Maine memories! Before leaving Maine, enjoy a photo stop of Maine's southernmost lighthouse, the Nubble Light before departing Maine. Enjoy a stop at Stonewall Kitchen in York, Maine, where you'll see the manufacturing of Maine jams, jellies, and condiments and a fabulous kitchen store with snacks.



Day 8 – Saturday, 10/11/2025 – Travel to your overnight hotel.
