Lopez Island Fire and EMS is recruiting students for our Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) course starting in November 2021.

- This will be a full certification course of approximately 200-hours.
- Attendance at ALL classes is mandatory.
- Classes will start November 10th and finish in early March 2022.
- There will be time off for major holidays.
- Classes will be held Wednesday evening and Saturday days, with some Friday evening and Sunday classes.

Applicants must:

- Be willing to help others, at all hours, and in all types of weather
- Be compassionate towards patients and the public
- Commit to attending drills and other trainings to maintain certification
- Be 18 years old by completion of the course
- Possess a state or federal valid identification (passport, driver's license, etc.)
- Be legally employable within the United States
- Be a High school diploma or have GED equivalency
- Have **NO** DUI or drug convictions and pass a police background check
- Must provide documentation of Covid-19 vaccination
