#### **New Business**

- Jason Burdine President of FBISD School BOard
  - Thanks to Mrs. Brown & her phenomenal staff
  - Thanks to Maddens for their involvement in the school, means a great deal to the community
  - Parents, volunteers (Mr. Taylor!)
  - Introuction
    - 5 years on the Board, in Aliana since '09
    - Believer in the value of leadership through volunteerism
    - 2 years ago school board of the year in TX
  - FBISD was Large District of the Year last year
    - 8<sup>th</sup> largest district in TX
  - Parent involvement, volunteerism & community make a large difference in schools that do well vs. schools that do not- Madden does all of these incredibly well
  - FBISD PD Safety and security is of paramount importance
  - As Board President speaks for Board, media interface, meeting chair, committee assignments (multiple committees)
  - Questions?
    - Bond? What facts can be given for it?
      - \$400M for construction, including at Madden
      - \$400M lifecycle deficiencies
      - \$15M Safety & Security
        - Most funding through Maintenance & Operations
      - See Flyer
      - Grading scale for financing
        - Technology 5 year financing
        - Buses 15 year financing
      - Avg. useful life of bond items 25 yrs
      - Avg. financing 14 yrs
    - Will schools being built be able to accomdate growth? Will salaries/staff be able to keep up with growth?

- 83% budget = salaries M&O, not Bond
- 5% = administration
- Forecast is reviewed every year with Pasa, but always a year behind the growth curve. Can't bond by forcasting the future.
- Percentage of Bond to be dedicated to FBISD 51, and when is 51 expected to be opened?
  - Plan to have school running in August, or maybe December
  - \$30-40 M Building now, borrowing against the future "Betting" on passing the bond, or will be funded out of general fund
- o Can you elaborate on addition to Madden?
  - 6 or 8 classrooms
  - Developers do not plan for schools. Madden property purchased long before the school
    was built, and substantial changes in that interim time.
- Building elementary schools, can Middle and High shools accommodate the population?
  - Programs (by policy) are portable
  - ex. Travis has an academy, that can be moved, if zoning area requires
- Project peak growth at 85-90K students in 10 years
  - Avg. age of buildings now 25 yrs
  - Revitalization will need to come down the line
- As planning takes place, does that consider the childrens' quality of experience?
  - Absolutely School Board focuses attention on curriculum, staffing, quality of education something we take very seriously.
  - Leadership is key
