 with the money they raised this year and PTO could do a beautification project, so we can
 replace and maintain the landscaping that was destroyed by the winter storm. PTO can work to
 remove and replace dead shrubs. PTO would maintain mulch and pruning biannually
- Husky of the month 10\$ to give to each teacher who works above and beyond. Treasurer would add a line item for the \$90 (rolled into the Teacher supply line item in the budget along with the stem gift cards)



Budget — Lauren Allaire

- Penny Wars to remain at \$3000
- Business Contributions and Sponsorships increased to \$7500
- Added Donation line item \$250 from the donation link on the square store
- School Supplies Sale \$0
- Field trip budget increased to \$10000 from \$7000 because we went over budget by \$818 this year
- Room parent budget increased to \$4500 from \$4000 because the full budget was not used this year
- Yearbook still \$3000
- Box tops reduced from \$250 to \$0
- Teacher School Supplies will be used for Husky of the month gift cards and Stem supply gift cards keeping the same budget
- Winning party expenses increased to \$100
- Classroom Enhancement fund increased from \$1500 to \$17500 to allow each teacher responsible for instruction who are PTO members \$250 each. There are currently 70 classroom teachers
- Accounting fees reduced to \$400 from \$700
- Postage and Mailing \$150
- Landscaping/ School Beautification will remain at \$750 until the we check on the sprinklers and receive an estimated cost for the landscaping
