Notes: Only select Madden Elementary and we will contact you. <u>Do not select all campuses</u>. Once your background check is cleared, you will receive an e-mail from the district stating that you are cleared to volunteer.

 - a. Complete the below form or the online form (sent via email by the campus VIPS Coordinator), to choose where you would like to help.
 - b. You will receive emails that will indicate volunteer opportunities throughout the year.


