NEW VENDOR GRANT


- NDFMGA grants \$500 to first and second year vendors selling at farmers markets or directly to consumers of 'Dakota Grown' products.
- Eligible for NDFMGA members,
- o Requires display of NDFMGA logo on materials.
- $\circ~$ GAP through Dakota College of Bottineau.

GRANT FOR NDFMGA MEMBERS

- NDFMGA offers \$500 mini grants for farmers markets and members to boost visibility, sales, and consumption of ND grown products.
- \$500 grant per applicant.
- o Funds used for promotional items, marketing, or events.
- Requires promotion of 'Dakota Grown, It's All Good' products.

YOUTH VENDOR GRANT

- Youth entrepreneurs ages 10-18 receive \$300 grants for farmers market ventures, emphasizing NDFMGA logo display and suply purchase.
- Eligible for two youth vendor grants, then new vendor grant.
- o financial aid for setting up at farmers markets.
- Requires display of NDFMGA logo on materials.
- Funds are for supplies and tools.
