Meet Your Neighbors

There's an old teal blue Ford pickup truck that's been a staple of the neighborhood for several years. If you've spent any time in St. Joseph, you've seen it! You may have wondered about its history or the person who owned it. This month we're sharing the full story about the truck and its owner, Ben, long-time resident of St. Joseph who also restored the Bodenmiller-Lanham House on 10th street.

Introductions

Hi, I'm Ben and I've lived in St. Joe for 10 years. I've recently been joined by my girlfriend Kelley and her favorite side-kick, Charlie, a 3-yr old golden-doodle. She grew up on the north side and works in the wine and spirits industry. My background is in construction management and so I serve on the neighborhood board as the official architectural reviewer. I examine proposed building plans and make sure they align with the official St. Joseph Historic Area Plan which helps preserve the historic integrity of the neighborhood.

Has the neighborhood changed in the last 10 years?

The sense of community between the neighbors is the biggest difference I've noticed. We interact with each other more and more. That may just be from living here for so long and slowly getting to know more people. Either way, I have really enjoyed my time here.

Favorite things?

The neighbors.

The charm.

The amount of things to do nearby.

How was restoring the 1865 Bodenmiller-Lanham house?

The house was in rough shape. It had the worst termite damage the exterminator had ever seen. I could poke my finger through the main beam and other structural elements! We took it down to the studs, repairing the core structure and foundation. All the windows were taken apart & rebuilt, along with siding repairs, tuckpointing and new electrical, plumbing & HVAC. We discovered 5 layers of shingles including the original cedar shakes!

The project took about 7 months. It was a really fun learning experience and I appreciated meeting all the neighbors who popped in to offer words of encouragement along the way.

What's the story behind the old Ford pickup?

I could go on and on about that truck! It started like many good stories do—at a bar. Late one night, I decided to find a truck just like my grandfather used to have, so I hopped on eBay and bought the best looking one I could find!

It was delivered on Halloween from Washington state. The described "not perfect but in really good shape" truck had a hole in the gas tank and other major issues. And, it took a private investigator to track down the title in Oregon!

It's needed a lot of work over the years but I love it! It's finally running well and I think of summers with my grandpa every time I drive it. We grandkids took that truck around his land in southern Indiana as soon as our tip toes could reach the pedals. Catch me at Ivy's and I'll share all the crazy details and stories!

November Board Meeting

The board met twice this month with full agendas at each session. Here's what was discussed!

New IU Health Hospital Campus

Adairius Gardner, Director of Government Affairs at IU Health, presented plans for the construction of a new IU Health hospital which will consolidate University Hospital & Methodist Hospital under one roof. This project is scheduled to be completed in 2026 and will have impacts on local traffic on 16th St, Senate Ave, & Capitol Ave as utilities are relocated in phases starting Dec 22 through March 7, 2022. Treasurer's Report

Association account balance was reported at \$1,006 and the foundation account at \$12,581.

Beautification Committee Report

- Fall cleanup will be Nov 13 at 9am
- Median adoption is still pending and a KIB little big grant application was submitted for the \$415 invested so far
- Identified a traffic signal box art program which could be utilized for the box in the median. Plan is to apply next year.
- Discussions are in the early stages for a public art tribute to Leah Orr. Details will be shared when a more formalized plan is available.
