CODE OF CONDUCT

RESPECT – DISCRIMINATION – CLEANLINESS – ADHAB - CHARACTER

As we run an Islamic education platform, one of our main emphasis will be to groom the next generation of Muslims by character-example. This “Code of Conduct” is for all guests at the Masjid, with an extra attention to Academy Students to adhere by the basic Islamic principles we have place for our center. By having this criterion in place, we will have a solid platform to build upon as we establish our identity, catering to the youth. This document should serve as a standard barrier and should be treated as a “Good Faith” understanding. Anyone violating these outliers will be sought for a discussion.

Masjid Ibrahim Academy has [5] important aspects to be followed at all times:

1. RESPECT

As Muslims we should always have a deep amount of “Respect” (Adhab) for all Muslims young & old. By giving respect, we inadvertently gain respect.

2. DISCRIMINATION

As Muslims we should never discriminate anyone based on their creed, nationality, gender, age, level of Islamic knowledge or any other form of biases.

3. CLEANLINESS

As Muslims we must always adhere to cleanliness and utilize Masjid property & materials with great care. Including bathroom visits and kitchen usage.

4. MASJID EQUIPMENT

All guests (including students) at the Masjid should treat all infrastructure with great concern. Tampering with any equipment is strictly forbidden.

5. MASJID ETIQUETTE

As Muslims our character is always on a full display to Allah (swt). In absence of people, we must also refrain from any harmful or illicit behavior in private.
