## **Top 10 Rules and Policies for BAYSA**

- Coaches need to have their Kidsafe card visible during all BAYSA and STYSA sanctioned events. Only 3 coaches on the sideline during game.
- 2. The actual, physical, Player Cards must be at the field during game, virtual cards are allowed but referees can require seeing the physical cards at any time.
- 3. A Coach may protesting a game when the laws of the game are not followed. Protests are not designed to argue judgement calls by the referee. (Example- Max roster of 12 and the other team has 14 on the bench). A protest must be lodged with the Center Ref and opposing coach before the game card is signed.
- 4. If you have a concern/issue about a referee who is unable to keep up with the skill or speed of the game, you can request a referee Review? Follow the process by emailing your club D&P. The Game card is NOT the place for these issues.
- 5. NO player pass or write ins for the Fall season, write ins are an auto forfeit.
- 6. Unsportsmanlike Conduct, "running up the score" of a 10-goal difference will result in a warning for the first offense and a suspension for all further offense. Warnings are carried over to the next season.
- 7. No Names on the back of the jersey, bags, and chairs
- 8. No Smoking (or Vaping) on or around the fields, the parking lot is the designated area.
- 9. No Drones by coaches and or spectators.
- 10. There is a zero tolerance of sideline misconduct, and referee abuse. Referee abuse is automatically reported to STYSA for action, coaches are suspended until ruling.
