

# Music and Friendship

## How to Play:

- 1. Pick a Square:** On your turn, choose any empty square on the board. Read the question in that square out loud.
- 2. Answer to Claim:** If you answer the question correctly, put your X or O in that square. If your answer is incorrect, you don't place a mark, and your turn ends.
- 3. Win the Game:** Take turns until someone gets three in a row. You can win by:
  - Three in a row across
  - Three in a row down
  - Three in a row diagonally
- 4. If It's a Tie:** If all squares are filled and no one has three in a row, the game ends in a tie.

# Music and Friendship - Answer Key

## Fair Play Options

1. **Teacher Verified Answers:** Students ask the teacher to verify the answer to a question.
2. **Groups of Three:** Turn the game into groups of three where a judge is chosen to verify the answer to a question.
3. **Student Self-Verification:** Students complete game and verify the answers themselves using notes or classroom resources. At the end of the game use the answer key to verify the answers.

1. Who is the main character in the story? → (William.)

2. What instrument does Carl play in the church? → (The organ.)

3. Who does William see that resembles him in the painting? → (Wilhelm, the son of Bach.)

4. What city does William live in? → (Paris.)

5. What famous composer is mentioned in the story? → (Johann Sebastian Bach.)

6. What piece of music does William hear being whistled? → (Bach's Little Fugue in G minor.)

7. What does William learn to play after meeting Carl? → (The piano and then the organ.)

8. What does the old man in the music shop suggest William would like? → (Fugues.)

9. How does William feel after he meets Carl and his family? → (Happy and not lonely anymore.)
