RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. <u>ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL and/or PRACTICE</u>
 - A. Must tell coach **BEFORE** practice.(at least 24 hrs notice)
 - B. Must be at practice the day before a game.
 - C. **TARDY** must sign-in by 10:00 am to practice or play
 - D. If absent must bring a note the next day
 - E. MISSED PRACTICE TIME make up with Running/Circuits & Meetings with position coach:
 - 1. **LATE** to practice (unexcused): Five (5) minutes.
 - 2. ABSENCES:
 - a. Unexcused 10 Minutes
 - * must make up meeting time with coach
 - 3. Time NOT made up: WILL NOT PLAY next game.
 - 4. **EXCESSIVE ABSENCES:** Removal from the team. (3 unexcused absences may result in removal from team)

II. IMPROPER BEHAVIOR ON AND OFF THE FIELD

- A. Punching, stealing, swearing, throwing helmet, failure to shake hands, displeasure of call, back talk.
- B. Disrespect for self, teammates, school, teachers, coaches.
- C. Any use of tobacco, alcohol, vaping or drugs. Is strictly prohibited. (Immediate removal from the team for any use of these.)
- D. All players are expected to conduct themselves as athletes, sportsmen and gentlemen at all times
- E. Cursing on the field will result in push-ups/extra running. **SUSPENSION OR EXPULSION** from the team as seen fit by the head coach.

III. TRAVEL TO AND FROM AWAY GAMES

- A. **EVERY** player will travel on the bus **BOTH** ways.
- B. At all times on the bus, all players are expected to follow Rules and Regulations.

IV. REQUIREMENTS FOR A VARSITY LETTER

- A. One quarter (1/4) of all possible Varsity Quarters. Must have 5 plays.
- B. All levels must finish the season to **COACHES' EXPECTATIONS.**
- C. Requirements to become a **CAPTAIN**
 - 1. Must be a hard worker **GOOD EXAMPLE** for others.
 - 2. Must display **POSITIVE** leadership.
 - 3. **FAILURE** to hold up to Mr. O'Connor's ideals will result in removal of the captainship.
- D. Game Captain based upon the performance in the previous game.
- E. Scout Team/Practice Captain based upon the performance and effort the week prior to the game.

V. ACADEMIC STANDARDS

- B. Mt. Olive High School Football Policy:
 - 1. PROGRESS REPORTS Given out every 3 weeks the first marking period, one (1) failing grade will result in two weeks probation.
 - 2. Following the probationary period,
 - a. ANOTHER report is issued.
 - b. Failing at this time will result in GAME SUSPENSION
 - c. Extra help and individual instruction by Mr. O'Connor/ Teacher until the grade is considered passing.
 - 3. All players will have **Study Table** on <u>Wednesday Nights</u> from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

VI. <u>FOOTBALL EQUIPMENT</u>

- A. All equipment must be SIGNED OUT BY EACH PLAYER
- A. Any item lost or stolen will be paid for.
- B. The Mt. Olive Football T-Shirt & Shorts, are not collected at the end of the season:
 - 1. Must be given back to Mr. O'Connor if the individual does not finish his football commitment **THROUGH HIS SENIOR YEAR.**
 - 2. **Mt. Olive FOOTBALL PLAYERS** work hard to earn their excellent reputation. I do not want anyone who **QUIT** the program to steal that honor.
