E ach Thanksgiving, the Ancient Order of Hibernians, St. Patrick's Division 1 -Somerset NJ and the Knights of Columbus -Somerville Council #1432 assemble turkey dinner packages with all the fixings for groups, food banks and families in need throughout Hunterdon, Somerset and Middlesex counties.

This year we are grateful to our generous sponsors the Colalillo Shop Rite of Flemington NJ and the parent company Albertson's to King's Market of Whitehouse Station NJ. We are also so very grateful to the generosity of the members, friends and families of our AOH Division and our Knights of Columbus Council. Thanks to the collective financial generosity, as well as folks time, sweat and heavy lifting, we were able to distribute a total of <u>120 Thanksgiving Turkey</u> <u>Dinners with all the fixings. This will feed over 500 of our neighbors in need. We have also delivered over 1,000 lbs. in food items to our two local food banks and distributed <u>\$825 in Shop Rite food cards.</u></u>
