## **Right to Life**

The NJ legislature is considering voting on NJ reproductive freedom act (s3030/a4848). Members are encouraged to contact their representatives in the assembly and senate. If passed, this bill would provide abortion access through 9 months of pregnancy, taxpayer-funded, with no provisions for resuscitation for survivors, no conscience rights for practitioners, and no parental consent needed. Additionally, it would provide access for those from out-of-state, making NJ a "haven" of sorts.
