Meet our 2024 Hibernian of the Year - Tom Lenahan

Tom was born in Somerville, N.J. in 1963 to Thomas and Catherine Lenahan. He is the oldest of four siblings, Kathleen Marconi, Michael Lenahan, Eileen Allen and Maureen Blejawas. They all grew up together in Branchburg, NJ. Tom graduated from Somerville High School in 1981 then went on to college earning his Bachelor of Science from Rutgers

University in New Brunswick.

In 1986, Tom was hired at Ethicon, Johnson & Johnson holding numerous positions within the sales division for 18 years leading him to medical device sales in New York City.

In 1990, Tom married Nancy Freda of Martinsville, NJ. As long time Bridgwater residents, Tom and Nancy have two Son's, Sean (29) with Fiancée Kelly Flannigan and Matthew (27) with Fiancée Lizzy Fuller. The Lenahan family is thrilled to be planning two weddings in 2025.

In 2004, Tom joined W. L. Gore & Associates, Inc. – Medical Products Division out of Flagstaff, AZ. He has held the position of Director, Corporate Accounts for the last 20 years supporting the sale and contracting of medical devices for vascular, cardiovascular and general surgery use at the largest health systems across the country.

Tom received his 3rd Degree as a Knight with the Knights of Columbus, Somerville Council 1432 in 1985. Tom then joined the Somerville Elks's Lodge 1068 and the Ancient Order of Hibernians – Saint Patrick's Division 1 – Somerset County with his dad. He took a temporary leave after his dad's passing in 1997 and to help Nancy raise their two boys.

Tom is a parishioner of Blessed Sacrament Church in Martinsville where he served as a Eucharistic Minister at both his parish and at Somerset Medical Center's Hospital Ministry under Rev. Msgr. Eugene Prus and Rev. Richard Rusk.

Now that Tom and Nancy are both empty nesters, Tom commits much of his time to the Ancient Order of Hibernians – Saint Patrick's Division 1 – Somerset County as Chairman of the Standing Committee where he also co-chairs the annual Thanksgiving and Easter food drive as well as co-chairing the Annual A.O.H. Catholic Mass honoring deceased AOH Brothers and LAOH Sisters.

Lastly, Tom has enjoyed his Irish Heritage and has fond memories of the Saint Patrick's Parade which then began in Bradley Gardens and marched across Route 206 to Downtown Somervile. Embracing those memories, Tom joined the Somerville Saint Patrick's Parade Committee and serves with a committed group of folks who work tirelessly to ensure the Somerville Saint Patrick's Parade continues to bring smiles in celebrating Irish Heritage and providing a community venue to cheer on and thank our Hometown Hero's and Community Volunteers the Sunday before Saint Patrick's Day in Downtown Somerville which follows the Parade Mass at Immaculate Conception Church and the raising of the colors at Borough hall.

Both Tom and Nancy will be quite busy with preparing for two upcoming weddings. In addition they also enjoy travelling, cheering on the NY Jets, Saint Joseph's University Men's Basketball (both boy's alma mater), visiting their sons and their fiancées in Philadelphia and spending summer weekends aboard their boat at Shelter Harbor Marina in Beach Haven NJ.
