

2021 ANNUAL THANKSGIVING DINNER PROJECT

We package and deliver between 60 – 80 baskets of food to needy families on the **Monday (Nov 22rd)** before Thanksgiving. Last year, recipients included S.H.I.P., Agape House, Binnacle House, Anderson House, Franklin Food Bank, Center for Great Expectations, Visions and Pathways, The Food Bank of Somerset County, Elijah's Promise, Centerbridge Senior Living and various Churches and Parishes.

How you can help

DONATE NON-PERISHABLE FOOD:
