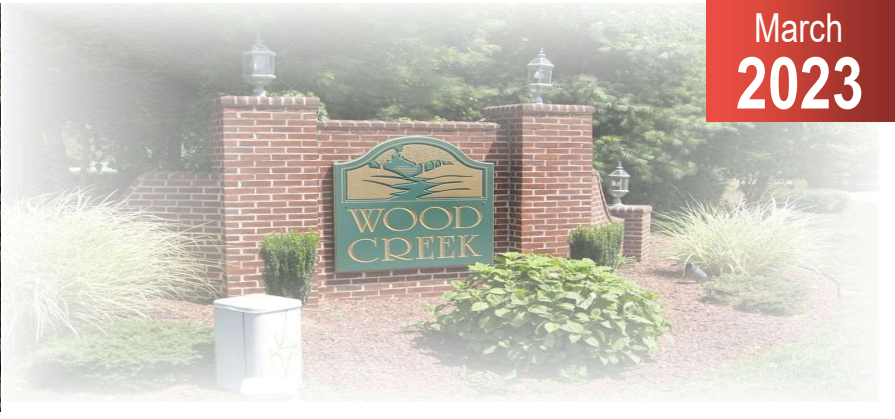

Big upgrade to our community park...
