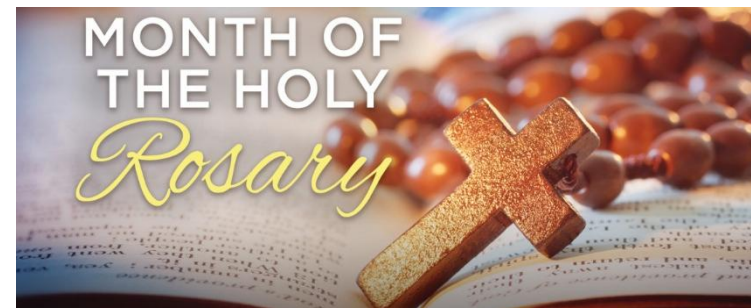

Join us for prayer, fellowship, and faith-inspiring talks during this Jubilee Year!

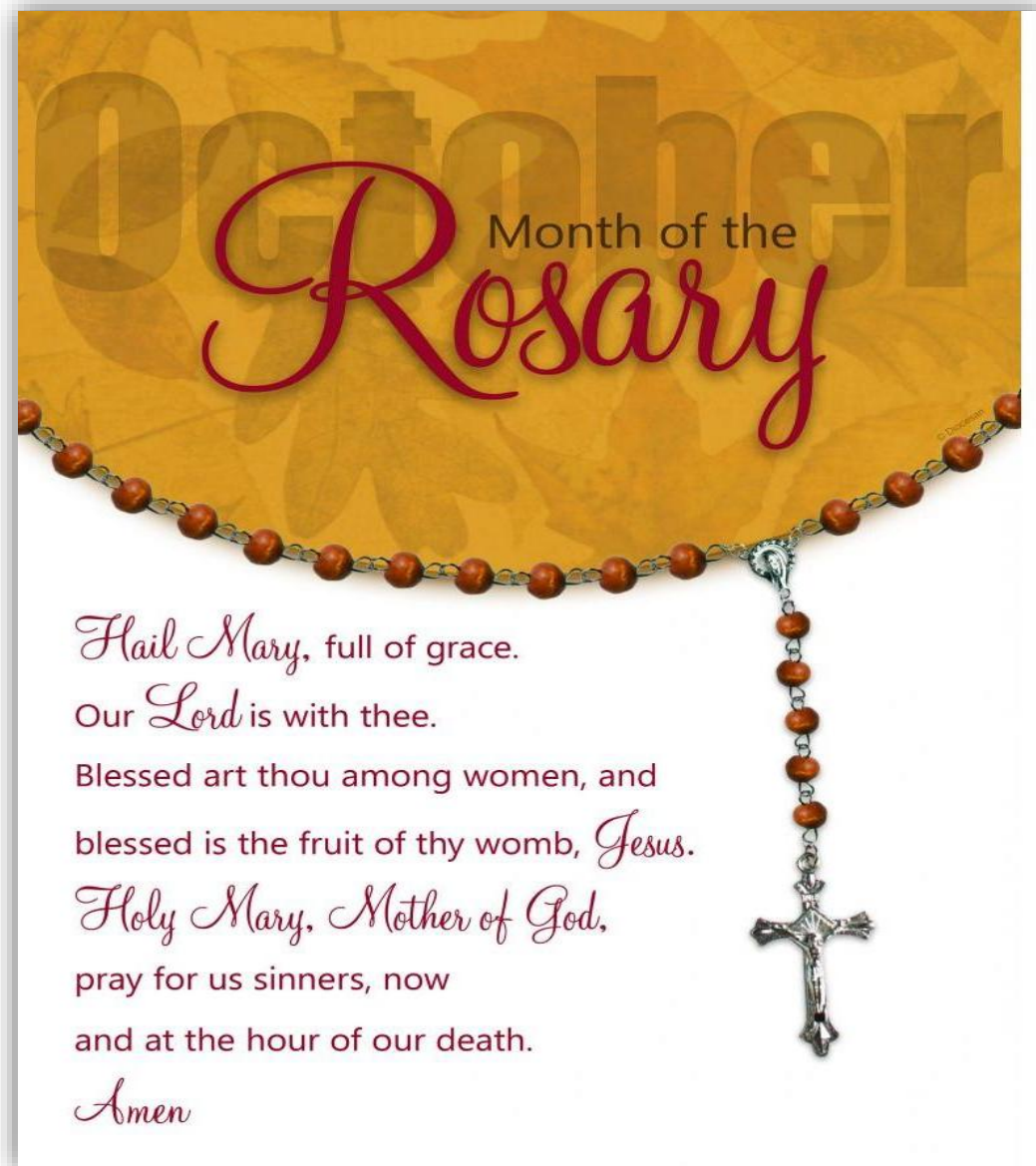
Our diocesan cathedral is the only designated Jubilee site in Rhode Island.
