### **The Visitation of the Missionary Image of Our Lady of Guadalupe**

The Missionary Image of Our Lady of Guadalupe will be visiting the diocese in various parishes throughout Rhode Island from Friday, Jan. 9, through Sunday, Feb. 1. The image is an exact replica of the original image of Our Lady, which she left on the Tilma of St. Juan Diego in December 1531, and is among four images blessed at the

Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Mexico by the Rector of the Basilica, Msgr. Monroy, to bring conversions, reverence for life, sanctity of the family, and solidarity of the Church in America.
