Children's Rosary - "Jesus & Mary"


We are inviting children one year and older to pray the Holy Rosary on Wednesdays from 6:30pm to 7:30pm. Each child will have the opportunity to pray.

- 12. The all-powerful love of My Heart will grant to all those who shall receive


