

Crochet Daisy Pattern.

Any thickness yarn, with appropriate size hook.

ch = chain

dc =double crochet

dtc = double treble crochet. (wrap yarn twice around hook before putting through next st and pulling through loop. This gives you 4 loops on hook to work with. Next, put yarn over hook and draw through 2 loops, yarn over hook and draw through 2 loops, yarn over hook and draw through remaining 2 loops.)

sl st = slip stitch

st = stitch.

YELLOW CENTRE.

Make a magic circle (4 ch and join to 1st chain) then put 6 dc into centre of circle. Join with sl st into 1st st of the round and ch 1.

Dc 9 st into CENTRE of magic circle to create a poofy yellow centre and sl st into 1st st in the round. (9st)

Break off yarn and weave in ends.

BLUE PETALS.

Insert hook into any of st in yellow base and join blue yarn.

Chain 4st, dtc into the same st where you joined, ch 4st and sl st into next st. Continue this pattern all the way around yellow base 8 more times (9 petals in total)

On reaching last petal, ch 5 and sl st in next st and break yarn. Weave in ends or leave and use these to attach to a strand of green (crocheted) chain stitches.
