## Recipe Corner by Becky Offutt

### Banana Bread

1/2 cup oil  
1 1/2 cup sugar  
2 eggs  
3 or 4 mashed ripe  
bananas  
1 t. soda  
1/2 t. baking powder  
1/2 t. salt  
2 cups flour  
1/2 chopped pecans or walnuts  
1 t. vanilla



Mix oil and sugar very well, add eggs. Mix in dry ingredients and alternate with mash bananas. Add vanilla and nuts. Bake at 350 degrees for approximately 45 minutes or until golden brown. This recipe makes 3 small loaves. I usually double the recipe.
