TRACK1

Consulting

Students learn technical interviewing skills for the different stages of a consulting interview. The steps include, but are not limited to, case structure, behavioral interview questions, and problem-solving assessments. Students receive expert coaching from consultants within and outside the Big Three to practice case interviews, apply relevant frameworks, and solve complex business problems.

TRACK 2
Entrepreneurship

Students receive instruction from successful entrepreneurs on how to create a business plan, raise the necessary capital to launch, identify and engage customers, and market their product or services.

The Make A Play Players Association (MAPPA) is the alumni network for D-League graduates entering their junior or senior year and professional athletes. In an increasingly competitive world, we help our MAPPA Fellows take their business data skills to the next level for specific industries. Students select one out of a possible six tracks: (1) Consulting; (2) Entrepreneurship; (3) Finance; (4) Front Office Management; (5) Law; and (6) Technology.

Through a clear and contextualized approach, MAPPA Fellows hone in on the skills that matter to them and their industry of choice the most through a microlearning platform designed by industry experts.

TRACK 3

Finance

Students learn how to analyze financial statements, apply credit and risk fundamentals to various roles, and perform complex company valuation. Additionally, they receive coaching from professionals across bulge-bracket investment banks and learn about career paths specific to the financial services industry.

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TRACK 4

Front Office Management

Students prepare to enter league and team offices by working hand-in-hand with current front office professionals to complete project-based assignments across various departments. Namely, students receive instruction in marketing and sales, client services, business development, and corporate strategy.

TRACK 5

Law

Students receive immersive mentorship and networking from legal professionals.
Additionally, they receive hands-on instruction in legal research and writing and how to prepare for law school exams strategically.

TRACK 6

Technology

Students receive personalized coaching and critical tools to help them secure high-trajectory roles in the tech industry. Through our performance dashboard and assessments, students develop their coding skills, network with recruiters from the top tech companies, and build their technical interviewing skills.
