



The AED is located on the wooden Fence to the left of the main entrance gates at 54 Tuparekura Road - Rec Centre. St John's keeps all public use AEDs locked with a combination padlock to prevent vandalism.

To access the code:

1. Dial 111 and ask for an ambulance.
2. Say the patient is unresponsive and CPR is underway, and you need access to an AED.
3. State the exact location of the AED: **54 Tuparekura Road, South Head Auckland**
4. Lift off the red outer cover.
5. Unlock the black cabinet **with the combination the 111 operator gives you.**
6. Unclip the two latches on the right hand side of the black cabinet.
7. An alarm will sound when the black cabinet is opened.

The Cell phone range at the gate is variable. We have tested it with Vodafone and with Spark phones. Both services have coverage. However, some phones do not have a strong antenna, limiting range, so you may have to move away from the gate to make the call. **You do not have to be standing at the gate to get the code.** You can request the code as soon as you dial 111.

Please, stop by the gate with your cell phone and check your cell phone coverage now so you can have a plan in place so that if there is an emergency, you are ready.

If an emergency occurs, it is best if there is one person assisting the patient and one person managing the phone and who could go get the AED. If you do not have phone numbers for

neighbours who can help, please let the committee know so that we can provide phone numbers you can have in case you are on your own with someone who needs this assistance.

We will be distributing a magnetic card with the essential information on it for easy access.

There will be a “Three steps to life” course held at the community centre as soon as it can be arranged.
