**Subject:** Regarding death of animals

Below I cite the most probable reasons for the death of goats belonging to Valsad Rural Police Station II, Cr. Reg. No. 3091/2015.

As per the report of Department of Veterinary Microbiology, College of Veterinary Science and A.H., Navsari Agricultural University, the goats suffered from Peste Des Petits Ruminants (PPR) which is an acute/subacute viral disease of goats and sheep characterised by fever, necrotic stomatitis, gastroenteritis, pneumonia and also death.

As the animals were being transported in over-crowded conditions, the air was ammoniated due to urine and stool passed by the goats. The inhalation of such air is harmful to the lungs and also deprives animals of oxygen. Also, stress results in decreased immunity; increasing chances of septicaemia and hence resulting in death.
