




PROGRESS REPORT 2021



HELLO UGSF FAMILY!

Dear Friends and Supporters of the Ugandan Girls Scholarship Foundation,

It has been a long, long time. We hope that you are well and that you have weathered the pandemic as well as possible too. We know that it has been challenging for many people in terms of health, finances, stress, and missing loved ones from afar. As with all of you, we too are hoping that we are turning a corner and that some degree of "normalcy" is on the horizon.

One more thing that makes us appreciate our position as Canadians in the developed world is watching our Ugandan friends navigate this pandemic. They have done so with grace, bravery and resilience. They have isolated at home without electricity, with limited food and little money. They have missed semesters as it simply wasn't possible for secondary schools to facilitate remote learning opportunities and village life without stable electricity makes it impossible. And yet, there is hope...

Our Ugandan liaison, Paul Mulondo, has been a stable force throughout the past 18 months remaining in close contact with us and with the girls in our program. He has navigated equipping the university level students with laptops and in some cases phones for educational use, so that they could adapt and participate in the limited offerings by some of the universities in the capital. Because of his tremendous efforts we are seeing a resurgence and are once again paying tuition, arranging accommodations, buying school uniforms and arranging access to technology.

We are thrilled to be back at it!


