#### Nick's Blog

We've reached the end of another year and now is the time to reflect and target areas for improvement in 2022.

I am currently still in France awaiting my Covid-19 test tomorrow afternoon. We have been away for 3 and a half weeks but are all keen to return home and get things up and running for 2022. People may not realise this, but during the sales season I find it very hard to sleep due to the thinking that goes on during the sales. Alot of the time the sales finish between 7 and 9pm and it is very hard to stop the mental processes and relax. I often find myself waking up in the night thinking about the horses that I bought and didn't buy.

I therefore felt that a good break away with plenty of physical activities was just what I needed to reset the body clock. It has definitely been the right type of break as I am now able to sleep through although with the Covid-19 outbreak in France in the last 10 days, I am a little concerned that I will pass the test to re-enter the UK.

We finished the Covid hit 2020 season in 4th position on the 2yo Leading Owners table behind Godolphin, Hamdam al Maktoum and Coolmore. In 2021 we have again finished in 4th position, this time behind Godolphin, Amo Racing and Cheveley Park. The following owners finished behind Nick Bradley Racing, Coolmore, Al Shaqab, Hamdam al Maktoum and Qatar Racing.

We finished the year with a total of 25 2yo winners, 87 places from 200 runs. This gave us a strike rate of 12.5%. More importantly we picked up £537,870 in prize money and by comparing purchase prices with realistic current valuations the 2yo cohort have increased in value from 1.1million to 2.2 million.

By employing the buying strategies of focusing on 2yo and 3yo fillies as much as possible we have been able to double the value of the stock.

I had a handful of owners contact me re being disappointed in the net earning their horses had delivered in 2021 as they expected the figures to be higher. Firstly I have to say I completely agree. Race entry fees are too high in many cases. The percentage of prize money that goes to the trainer and the jockey are too high, particularly the trainer.





In my opinion, Brexit has caused as much harm to the UK as Covid has and in terms of effecting Nick Bradley Racing, Brexit has meant the cost of sending horses to race in Ireland and France has doubled in terms of transport, customs, veterinary costs and needless paperwork.

Given the higher costs and desperate levels of prize money on offer in the UK it further strengthens my policy on focusing on the 2yo and 3yo fillies races. Looking at our just turned 3yos valuation they have doubled in value in the course of the year. The 2020 2yo cohort on the whole averaged around a 300% return which again makes the levels of prize money a more insignificant issue.

These returns are without doubt the highest achieved by any racing operation and the aim has to be to continue to operate at an average appreciation of a minimum of 200%.

We managed to achieve 5 Stakes Winners in 2021 from a total of 48 runners who ran 289 times in the calendar year. To identify how successful these statistics are we should compare them to the leading stallions statistics as data for other owners and trainers in terms of Stakes victories is not readily available.

Camelot, Teofilo and Wootton Bassett all achieved 5 Stakes victories in GB and Ireland in 2021.

Camelot, standing for 75,000 Euros had 5 Stakes victories from 138 runners who ran 643 times.

Teofilo, standing for 30,000 Euros had 5 Stakes victories from 108 runners who ran 484 times.

Wootton Bassett, standing for 150,000 Euros had 5 Stakes victories from 34 runners who ran 157 times.

Our performance compares favourably against Camelot and Teofilo but isn't as impressive as Wootton Bassett.

That said Wootton Bassett's covering fee of 150,000 is significantly more than our average yearling/2yo purchase cost which is just under £25,000.

Frankel was declared leading stallion in 2021 with the following statistics: Frankel 186 runners, 16 Stakes victories. 1 in 11.625 runners won at Stakes level in 2021





Nick Bradley Racing 48 runners, 5 Stakes victories.1 in 9.6 runners won at Stakes level in 2021.

Again, our statistics compare favourably with Frankel who will stand for £200,000 in 2022.

Nick Bradley Racing achieved £917.418 in prize money in 2021 from 48 runners. An average of £19,112 per horse.

We can compare this average against the three leading stallions who stood in Uk and Ireland:

Frankel progeny achieved £5,262,569 in prize money from 186 runners, an average of £28,293 per runner.

Dubawi 's progeny achieved £3,599,497 in prize money from 186 runners, an average of £19,352 per runner.

Galileo progeny achieved £3840,486 in prize money from 198 runners, an average of £19,396 per runner.

The average yearling price by these stallions in 2021 was £470,000, whereas Nick Bradley Racing's average yearling spend was just under £25,000. Again, these figures compare favourable for Nick Bradley Racing.

Anyway, enough of the looking back and time to look forward. First and foremost I am confident that 2022 will be a more successful year on the track for Nick Bradley Racing. I have this confidence from the yearling sales where I feel that I have been able to buy a better horse due to various sales being weak and by improving my buying strategy as I have done year on year. The next goal is to buy better horses from the 2022 breeze ups and privately over the coming months. I am already talking to the leading consignors and will be sent work videos of horses from mid-January onwards.

Olly Batchelor left the organisation at the end of 2021 and has been replaced by Harry Hollingworth. Harry has a degree from Goldsmiths University, London and has worked for Weatherbys, Hot to Trot Racing and has a Diploma in Stud Management from the National Stud. Harry will be joined in the role in the Spring by another team member who will be announced in the coming weeks.

We will continue to focus the majority of our runners on the 2yo and 3yo race between May 1st and November 1st. We will have a slightly bigger cohort of horses in 2022 with





around 50 2yos in training and around 20 3yo and older horses. I will continue to target the fillies and aim them at the Stakes races in the UK, Ireland and France.

#### Success in 2022 will look like the following:

- 6-8 Stakes victories.
- In excess of £1 million of prize money earnings.
- Our end of year valuation to be around 250% of their purchase costs.
- 40 victories.
- A high level of **Customer satisfaction** both on and off the track.
- A top 3 position in terms of 2yo Owners in the UK.

All that is left to say is that I will continue to strive to be the best, continue to be 100% honest and transparent at all time and do my utmost to make my dreams come true as well as yours.

## OVER 3000% RETURNS AT THE DECEMBER MARE SALES, NEWMARKET



We recently saw some great results at the December Mares sale at Newmarket. Three fillies that have bought us great fun over the last few years went on to bring in nearly 2,000,000gns between them. With an average costing of £20,000 each, it's been great to see some brilliant returns for our members. Dandalla (pictured above) who won the Albany Stakes at Royal Ascot in 2020 was sold to Japanese interests for 750,000gns, she will go travel to Katsumi Yoshida's Northern Farm. Fev Rover was sold for 695,000gns scoring in the Group 2 Prix du Calvados and 3rd in the 1,000 Guineas, her career is far from over and will remain in training in the US.





Mystery Angel who won the Listed Pretty Polly Stakes and runner-up to Snowfall in the Oaks was sold for 500,000gns, who has also gone over to Japan.

## HONEY SWEET BEATS HELLOMYDARLIN TO LAND A 1-2 FOR NBR IN THE PRIX ZEDDAAN







Honey Sweet got her head in front for the first time since May at Nottingham when she made all to win the Prix Zeddaan from fellow NBR rival Hellomydarlin.

It was a brilliant day for Nick Bradley Racing owners securing a 1-2 in another stakes race. The 1-2 today we have gone past £500,000 in prize money for our 2yo's in 2021. 36 2yo's have run in our colours this year, 15 have won at 42% wins/runners. 13 of our 2yo's have run in Black Type races with 7 of the 2yo's earning Black Type meaning 20% of our 2yo's have earned Black Type.

Both our horses went to the front on the rain softened ground at Deauville on Tuesday afternoon and perhaps the stand side rail aided Honey Sweet a touch more than Hellomydarlin which meant that Honey Sweet was able to repel the challenge in the dying stages to pull away by a length.

#### 67.5% Left in Dabirism x Ajab Bere



This filly was purchased by Nick at the Arqana October Yearling Sales for 26,000 Euros.

Nick applied his usual level of patience in the early stages of the five day sale and waited for many of the agents to leave after days 1 and 2. As usual the market dropped off in the second half of the sales and this filly presented excellent value.

This filly stands around 15'3 so she isn't small and is on the upper limit of the size of horse Nick is looking to purchase. With that in mind she is





definitely a filly for the middle of the 2yo season onwards rather than the early months.

She has a good action and covers alot of ground. She has excellent confirmation and is quite a heavy/strong filly typical of her sire Dabirsim. Nick still regrets the day he didn't purchase Different League as a yearling and on seeing this filly Different League was exactly what he was seeing in front of him. This filly moved in the same manner at Different League but is a bigger scopier model so you would imagine that she would take a little bit longer to come to hand.

Looking at the pedigree she is out of a Rock of Gibraltar mare. On researching the Dabirsim X Rock of Gibraltar cross it has been bred five times producing two horses who were moderate, two rated in the 80s and one of the best daughters of Dabirsim in Coeur de Beaute who achieved an OR of 109.

She joins Karl Burke who Nick has teamed up so well with in recent years with the likes of Dandalla, Guilded, Honey Sweet, Fast Response, Little Kim and Sophie's Star to name but a few.

#### 50% left in Whitecliffsofdover x Fresh Laurels



This filly was purchased by Nick Bradley from Arqana V2 on the 17th August for 22,000 Euros.

Nick had had a fruitless first three days of the sale with him progressively getting closer to buying our first yearling of the 2021 sales. By the fourth day of the sales alot of the agents and larger buyers had left town and it presented a far better opportunity for Nick to get involved.





Nick viewed all of the fillies at the sale and ended up with a shortlist of 16 fillies for the final day.

This filly stood our as being a very good model, with a great shape and an excellent action. Physically Nick felt there was plenty of improvement to come in this filly as she was under prepped for the sale. That said, she was a strong filly with a good hip, and excellent drive from her hind quarters.

Nick loves to buy the best fillies by unfashionable stallions as it offers investors the opportunity to access the best racehorses at a lower price. Mystery Angel (Kodi Bear), Fev Rover (Gutaifan), Dandalla (Dandy Man), Honey Sweet (Adaay), and Little Kim (Garswood) are all examples of success Nick Bradley Racing have had using this angle.

Whitecliffsofdover is a son of War Front who was solid but not spectacular on the track with his highlight probably being his third place finish in the Jean Luc Lagadere. He has had 2yos run on the track in 2021 who have ran with credit. Looking at the dam 'Ajab Bere' she is already the dam of two 2yo winners, including the unbeaten Juste Bere who is 3 from 3 at the time of writing.

Karl and Kelly Burke both liked what they saw in this filly and were very keen to train her for Nick Bradley Racing. Karl is an excellent trainer of 2yos in Nick's eyes and they have teamed up with Dandalla, Little Kim, Honey Sweet, Guilded and Fast Response to name just a handful of Group class 2yo fillies they have teamed up with.

We expect this filly to start over 6 furlongs in May and progress to be a 7 to 8 furlong filly by the end of the season.

#### 57.5% left in Shalaa x Kisses Of Love



This filly was bought by Nick at the Arqana October Yearling Sales on 19th October for 38.000 Euros.

As always Nick made a point of seeing every filly at the sale and on this occasion, there were just short of 400 fillies on offer. This filly was up there in the best 2% on offer in Nick's opinion.

She is a very good model who is strong, has good confirmation and an excellent action. Physically she looks definitely the type for the second half





of the 2022 season rather than the first half. She stands around 15'3 and is a heavy/strong filly who will want at least 7 furlongs in Nick's opinion. She is a similar model to Fev Rover but probably a bit stronger with it, her 3yo career should be every bit as good as her 2yo career if not better.

Shalaa was a Morny and Middle Park Group 1 winning son of Invincible Spirit over 6 furlongs but his progeny have tended to want a bit further and that looks the case with this filly who is out of a Le Havre mare who again would be a stamina influence.

She joins Johnny Murtagh who is a very passionate trainer based in Ireland who has done so well with his fillies on the track in recent years. Eddie Linehan who works the sales for Johnny was also a huge fan of this filly and he was very keen for Johnny to train her.

#### 30% left in Pedro The Great x Exitante



This filly was purchased by Nick at the Arqana October Yearling Sales for 25,000 Euros.

Nick looked at everyfilly at the sales and felt this filly was definitely one of the most precocious fillies on offer. Nick has now purchased three fillies in 2021 from Haras de la Haie Neuve and the breeder seems to offer excellent value for money as he doesn't set huge reserves.





The day following the purchase of this filly, the Prix De Isonomy was won by Mister Saint Paul, a Dariyan colt he sold for 11,000 Euros this time last year. This confirms Nick's thoughts re buying horses from this specific breeder.

This filly is a very strong filly and very much has the frame of a sprinter. She has a good shoulder, good hip and moves well. She doesn't have the perfect confirmation in front but after speaking with some renowned French breeders they confirmed that Pedrothegreat himself had poor confirmation which he has passed on to some of his stock. This is a low risk issue and shouldn't discourage people from investing in her. Nick could real off a list of horses with less than perfect front legs including Group 1 winning Donjuan Triumphant who he purchased for just 30,000 Guineas.

This filly is likely to be one of our first runners of 2022, she should debut in April/May over 5 furlongs and her optimum trip is likely to be 6 furlongs.

She joins Laura Vanska who is training out of a state of the art facility in Troam which is 30 minutes from Deauville. Laura has already had 3 winners from her new yard from a small group of horses including Baptista who is now Stakes placed.

#### 10% left in Dandy Man x Born To Spend



This filly was bought by Nick from the Book 3 sales for 42,000 Guineas on October 15th.

Nick secured this extremely strong daughter of Dandy Man on the evening of the final day of the Book 3 sale. She is a knockout physically and stands up an absolute powerhouse of a filly. She walks well enough and very much looks and moves like a sprinter. She has good confirmation and looks like a strong/sound horse.

Nick's record purchasing progeny of Dandy Man is pretty much second to none with the likes of Dandalla, Consequences and Dainty Dandy all bought cheaply proving to be top class performers. At 42,000 she had Nick filly stretched to the max but he was keen to secure her and get the better of





#### underbidder Stuart Williams.

This mare is the first foal out of the winning Born to Sea mare Born to Spend. We expect this filly to debut over 6 furlongs in May and hopefully be one of the horses we are aiming at the Albany at Royal Ascot.

She joins Karl Burke who Nick has teamed up with with the likes of Dandalla (Dandy Man), Honey Sweet, Guilded, Fast Response, Little Kim and Sophie's Star to name but a few of the success stories in recent years.

#### 18% left in Elzaam x Instant Memories



This filly was purchased by Nick Bradley at the Goffs Sportsmans Sale on 30th September 2021.

Nick has noticed that the prices are dropping dramatically towards the end of sales this year and that was the case with this filly. This daughter of





Elzaam is an excellent mover as are many of Elzaam's stock. She is a good physical for a filly that was born on April 17th and she should strengthen and develop over the coming months. She has good confirmation but is not perfect as she toes in every so slightly on her near fore but that should not be an issue.

Her dam Instant Memories has been covered by Elzaam on each of the last four years and she has already produced the very good horse Vincy who won twice in Ireland before being sold to Hong Kong for a huge six figure amount.

Joe Foley who stands the stallion Elzaam told Nick after he had purchased her that she was the second best physical to come from the mare and was a far nicer model than Instant Return and Classy Choice.

Nick would expect this filly to debut over 7 furlongs in June/July.

When she walked into the ring Nick was prepared to bid up to 20,000 Euros for her so she offers tremendous value, George is very keen to train the cheaper of Nick's purchases as he has excelled at winning the Restricted Band C and D races in 2021.

This filly offers an opportunity for owners to get involved with Nick and George who have combined in 2021 to win three Stakes races with Oscula, Corazon and Mystery Angel who was also 2nd in the 2021 Group 1 Oaks at Epsom.

#### 40% left in Kheleyf x Laureva Chope



This filly was purchased by Nick Bradley from the Osarus Yearling Sale for 16,000 Euros.

This was a sale which was very poorly attended, and Nick had the pick of the fillies on offer. He felt there were 5 or 6 stand out fillies in the sale and this filly was up there with the best on offer. She is a strong filly who comes from a vendor who is well known for selling fast horses including the likes of Sands of Mali.

She looks every inch a sprinter and is probably going to be one that improves alot physically over the next 6 months. She has a good sprinter's action, her confirmation isn't perfect but Nick was happy with it.





She is the second foal out of the mare Laureva Chope who is a sister to the dam of Goken who was a very fast horse winning multiple Group 3's and was 3rd in the King's Stand.

We expect her to be out in May over 5 furlongs based on her pedigree and physical make up. Her purchase price of 16,000 Euros means she qualifies for Band D races, so she is able to run in any of the 2yo races open to fillies.

She joins George Boughey who has had many 2yo winners in 2021 and has done so well with Nick Bradley Racing runners Mystery Angel, Oscula, Corazon and Hellomydarlin.

Nick had a shortlist of around 16 fillies selling on the final day of the sale and this filly was towards the top of the list in terms of the fillies we were hoping to secure.





She is an excellent physical and up there with the nicest 2yo filles in the entire sale. She is a good size standing around 15'2 to 15'3. She had been well prepped for the sale and was in great condition. She has a very strong action and is a very good looking filly. Nick was very keen to secure this filly and stretched from his original budget of 30,000 Euros to 40,000 to secure her. Federico Barberini underbid the filly, who Nick had to outbid to secure Simply Gorgeous at the 2020 sales.

When Nick returned to video the filly after she had been through the ring, her lead up girl was delighted Nick had bought her and described her as a queen with a great temperament who was awesome in the lunge ring.

She is the third foal out of the William Haggas trained mare Trainnah. On the track, Trainnah won twice and achieved an official rating of 87 from a short five race career. Her second foal by Ribchester ran 4th on debut at Longchamp in June in what looked a very competitive 6.5 furlong race. She has an excellent pedigree being a sister to Group 2 winner James Garfield and from the family of Group 1 winners Uni, Invincible Spirit and Juddmonte winning Mishriff to pick out just a few names from the pedigree. We expect this filly to debut in the middle of the 2022 season and be one who we start over 7 furlongs and she could end up racing over 8 to 10 furlongs.
