

Danbury Duck Race Rules

1. The number printed on purchased tickets corresponds to 1 rubber duck having the same number.
2. No entries may be sold after the ducks have entered the water.
3. Ducks are the same shape, size, and weight; and all ducks are released at the same time into the Yellow River.
4. The race takes place in the Yellow River, depending on conditions it may begin where the Gandy Dancer Trail crosses the river and end in the area of the WI ST 70 bridge south of the town or begin at the WI St 70 bridge south of town and end in the area of the WI St 70 Bridge crossing the river on the north side of Town. Viewing the race is best down from the area of the bridges, but please be careful of motor vehicle traffic. The land below the north bridge is owned by the St Croix Tribal Enterprises and requires permission to enter the property.
- 5.. Once the ducks are in the water they cannot be touched, advanced or manipulated.
6. All winners are responsibility for any applicable fees or taxes.
7. A corresponding master list of all tickets/entries sold and unsold is maintained by the Danbury Area Chamber Inc. For purposes of this raffle, entries are the actual numbered ducks placed in the water and they correspond to the master list.
8. If a winning duck is determined to be an "unsold" entry, the winning prize will revert to the next qualified (sold) duck to cross the finish line.
9. Entry in the duck race is not conditional upon any other purchase.
10. All prizes available will be publicly posted where tickets are sold, in the community and at the prize announcement site.
11. If the duck race is unable to be conducted due to weather or other circumstances, the winner(s) will be determined by the standard method of drawing ticket stubs from a container.
