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Dr. M. L. G. Gonzalez Charter School students to learn online from August 13-Sept. 4, 2020

During this difficult time and the level of COVID19 cases in Corpus Christi our school will provide remote instruction and teacher made instructional packets for our students commencing on the first day of school, Thursday, August 13th, 2020 through Friday, September 4th, 2020. Texas State Officials, Local Officials and the TEA has allowed schools in Texas to offer this instructional flexibility as a way to help maintain student, staff and parent safety.

Classroom/ face to face instruction will be provided beginning Tuesday, September 8th, with remote instruction remaining as an option for parents that still do not want their child/children to return to a face to a face classroom setting. If you, the parent or your child/children need technical assistance with online learning please feel free to contact the school and we will be more than glad to provide assistance.

Every child enrolled in our school will be provided with an IPAD and a Hotspot (per family) if their household does not have internet capability that the student can use in order to complete their daily assignments. Please keep in mind that the IPADs and the Hotspots are being checked out to the parent/child and must be returned when face to face instruction begins with the students, unless the parent is opting to have their child continue with remote learning, then the IPAD and Hotspot will be turned in at the end of the student need for the equipment. **If the IPADs or Hotspots are lost, stolen or broken the parent will be required to pay the replacement cost of lost item/items. Parents will be contacted before school begins and provided a pick-up date and time to come to the school to pick up the instructional packets, IPADS and a Hotspot if one is needed. If you have internet capabilities at home please do not request a Hotspot, we do not have a device for every child in our school.**

Remote instruction will include live and recorded formats, which will be determined by the grade level teachers and the campus administration. Online instructional programs will also be utilized for daily instruction. Daily work/assignments must be completed and submitted on a daily basis in order to receive a daily grade for the assignment. A numerical grade will be given for all assignments or as best suited for the course.

Attendance will be taken daily by the teachers or a staff member so that we may count a student present for the day! It is imperative that we have a contact phone number, an email address for the parent etc. in order to make daily contact to establish your child's daily attendance. Teachers may also use a "Zoom" platform at a particular time of the day for every child to log in and this may also be the manner in which attendance and daily contact with the students may be established. The teachers/staff will be contacting parents and students to discuss their expectations for attendance procedures and daily instructional delivery when school begins and throughout the 4 week period.
