- o Going to Restaurant Depot and passing out items for the community
- In talks withMack Academy we discussed donated shelf stable items and toiletries as opposed to donating perishables
- We need to be effective and strategic about finding out who needs these items and how to distribute them
- Looking at either buying items online or finding a store without quantity restrictions
 - Partnering with the food bank also has large pre packed food boxes that can feed a family of four for 4 or 5 days so that is also a route that we can take
 - 5 Toiletries items
 - Toilet paper, soap, toothpaste, disinfecting wipes, rubbing alcohol
- We should identify at least three locations in 7F where people can come pick up items
