

LESSON 9:

HOLINESS

Big Idea: Holiness is not about perfection—it's about being set apart for God.

Scripture Anchor: 1 Peter 1:15–16, Hebrews 12:14



THE WORD HOLINESS CAN FEEL HEAVY

For some, it sounds like rules: *"Don't do this, don't do that."* For others, it feels impossible: *"I'll never measure up."*

But holiness isn't about legalism—it's about **belonging**. To be holy means to be "**set apart**" for God.

"Just as He who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do; for it is written: 'Be holy, because I am holy.'"

— 1 Peter 1:15–16

Hebrews 12:14 reminds us: *"Without holiness, no one will see the Lord."* Holiness is not optional—it's central to knowing God. Here's the truth: holiness isn't about being perfect—it's about **living different**. When you know who you belong to, you'll live set apart. Holiness isn't a burden—it's your calling, your freedom, and your witness to the world.



DIFFERENT BY DESIGN

Ever notice how athletes set themselves apart? Diet, training, discipline—it's not punishment, it's **preparation**. They live different because they have a different goal.

That's holiness. It's not God trying to make your life boring—it's God preparing you for **purpose**. Holiness means you don't blend in—you stand out for Jesus.

📌 **Key Insight:** Holiness isn't restriction—it's preparation for something greater.

THREE KEY PRINCIPLES OF HOLINESS



HOLINESS MEANS BEING SET APART

You're not ordinary—you're chosen for God's purposes



HOLINESS FLOWS FROM RELATIONSHIP, NOT RULES

Stay close to Jesus and you'll grow holy naturally



HOLINESS IS EMPOWERED BY THE SPIRIT

The Spirit gives you power to live set apart daily

PRINCIPLE 1: HOLINESS MEANS BEING SET APART

Holiness isn't just about avoiding sin—it's about being **set apart for God's purposes**. You're not ordinary; you're chosen.

"You are to be holy to me because I, the Lord, am holy, and I have set you apart from the nations."

— Leviticus 20:26

"Offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God."

— Romans 12:1



Illustration: Think of cutlery at a wedding. The "set apart" pieces aren't for everyday use—they're for something *special*. That's you—you're set apart for God's glory.

One-liner: "Holiness isn't about rules—it's about who you belong to."

PRINCIPLE 2: HOLINESS FLOWS FROM RELATIONSHIP, NOT RULES

Legalism says, *"Do this to be holy."* Relationship says, *"Stay close to Jesus and you'll grow holy."* Holiness is **fruit**, not forced effort.

"If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit."

– John 15:5

Holiness comes from **abiding in Christ**—staying connected to Him daily through prayer, Scripture, and worship.

"For God did not call us to be impure, but to live a holy life."

– 1 Thessalonians 4:7

God calls us to live holy—not for religion, but **for Him**. It's personal, not transactional.

Illustration: Like hanging around a friend whose habits rub off on you—spending time with Jesus *changes* how you live. You become like the One you spend time with.

One-liner: "Holiness isn't behavior modification—it's heart transformation."

PRINCIPLE 3: HOLINESS IS EMPOWERED BY THE SPIRIT

We can't live holy by willpower alone. We need the **Holy Spirit's power** working in us every single day.

"Walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh."

— Galatians 5:16

"It is God who works in you to will and to act in order to fulfill his good purpose."

— Philippians 2:13

God doesn't just command holiness—He *empowers* it. The Spirit gives you both the desire and the ability to live set apart.



Illustration: Think of power tools. They're useless until plugged into power. The Spirit is your **power source** for holiness.

❏ **Modern Connection:** Everyone else says "follow your heart." The Spirit says "follow Me." That's where real freedom is found.

One-liner: "Holiness isn't you trying harder—it's you depending deeper."

CLEARING UP MISCONCEPTIONS ABOUT HOLINESS



"HOLINESS IS BORING"

Truth: Holiness is the most exciting life—free from sin, full of God's presence and purpose.



"HOLINESS MEANS PERFECTION"

Truth: Holiness means progress—daily becoming more like Jesus, one step at a time.



"HOLINESS IS LEGALISM"

Truth: Holiness flows from love, not law. It's relationship-driven, not rule-driven.

LIVING HOLY: WHAT IT LOOKS LIKE

When you live holy, you live **free, focused, and fulfilled**. Here's how holiness transforms your everyday life:

Θ1

SET APART

You belong to God—your identity comes from Him, not the world's approval.

Θ2

RELATIONSHIP-DRIVEN

Stay close to Jesus through daily time in His presence—holiness grows naturally from intimacy with Him.

Θ3

SPIRIT-LED

Holiness is possible every day when you depend on the Holy Spirit's power, not your own strength.

Final One-liner: "Holiness isn't about being perfect—it's about being set apart."



PRACTICAL EVERYDAY TAKEAWAYS

CHOOSE DIFFERENT

This week, make one decision that sets you apart for God. What will you watch, listen to, or say no to in order to honor Him?

STAY CLOSE TO JESUS

Spend time daily in prayer and the Word. Holiness grows from His presence—make space for Him every single day.

DEPEND ON THE SPIRIT

Before each day begins, pray: *"Holy Spirit, help me live set apart today."* Invite His power into every moment.

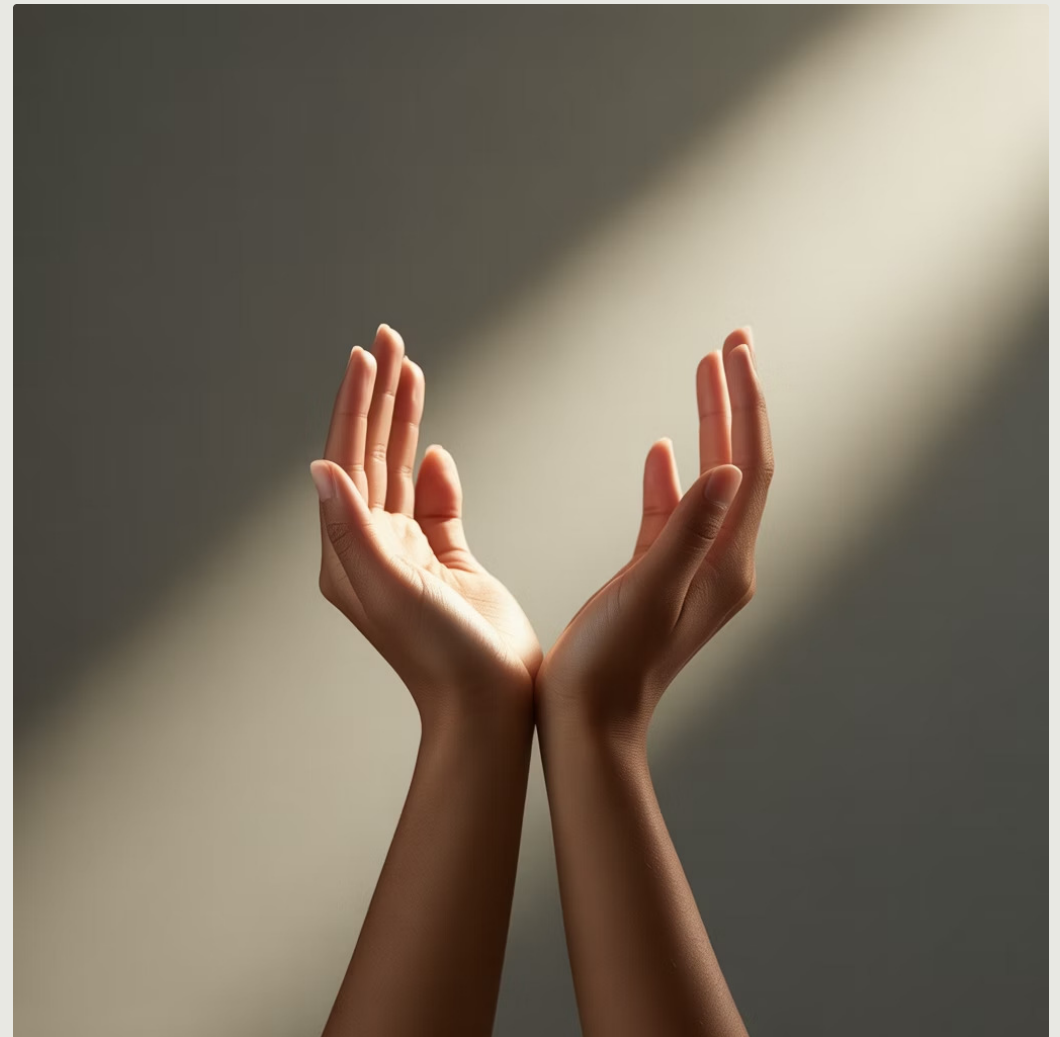
YOUR WEEKLY CHALLENGE
