The 40 Days of Instruction

Before ascending, Jesus spent 40 days teaching His disciples about the Kingdom of God. This wasn't a ghost story; it was a period of intense preparation.

THE KINGDOM IS NOT AN INSTITUTION.

We often confuse the “Kingdom of God” with religious structures.

INSTITUTIONS

Rely on policies, constitutions,
and systems.

Seek to control and
manipulate humanity.

Established by fiberglass,
bricks, and bureaucracy.

THE KINGDOM

Not of this physical world.

Established by the Spirit.

Operates on liberty,
not control.



Institutions Control. The Kingdom Liberates.

In the Old Testament, empires were built on gods of stone. Today, institutions often look like denominations or political systems designed to “clean” or “process” humanity.

“The Kingdom is not just to keep you here and make you feel good... it is not to control people by policies.”

The Kingdom of God is within you.

Jesus did not come to set up a political cabinet.
He came to establish a Kingdom in the hearts of people.
It is a transformation of thinking, a “shutting of the door”
on the noise of society to find the reality of God inside.

The Kingdom is removed from the culture of Earth and connected directly to the Spirit.

Beyond the Academic Mind

You cannot understand the Kingdom through intellect alone.
The “academic world” and human education have limits.
The Kingdom is Supernatural.
